Primary Issues and Demands laid down by CTG leaders

- » kahirapan at pagtaas ng presyo ng bilingin
- » reporma sa lupa/land distribution
- » pagsuko at amnesty

Results of Levelling Session and Exploratory Dialogue

kahirapan at pagtaas ng presyo ng bilihin

- » CTG members noted that one of the motivations why they joined the CTG, particularly the NPA, is to find solution to their poverty
 - › citing that their situation worsens
 - ≈ prices of basic commodities continue to increase
 - ≈ income of the farmers remains meager

Results of Levelling Session and Exploratory Dialogue

reporma sa lupa and land distribution

- » CTG members and their communities are continuously being driven away by claimants
 - › despite having in their possession a Certificate of Land Ownership Awards (CLOA)

Results of Levelling Session and Exploratory Dialogue

amnesty and pagsuko

- » raised a concern on the sincerity of the government in assisting those who intend to return to the folds of the law
 - › those who plan to surrender are wary of the process since most of the time, there is no development in the processing of their surrender

amnesty and pagsuko

- » main concern is on documentation/proof of surrender and existing warrants against those who are planning to surrender
