SUBJECT : PREPARATIONS FOR LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA)
EAST SOUTHEAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR


DATE : 05 APRIL 2022

Based on NDRRMC Weather Updating conducted on 05 April 2022, at 10:00AM, the center of the Low Pressure Area was estimated at 180 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.6N, 127.8E).

In this connection, all RDRRMC Member Agencies and Chairperson of LDRRMCs are hereby directed to undertake the following preparedness actions in connection with the Low Pressure Area.

1. Monitor closely the bulletins, warning and other advisories issued by DOST-PAGASA, DENR-MGB and other surveillance agencies. Cross validate the current situation with the Doppler radar images, satellite images, and other science-based monitoring and forecasting tools;
2. Initiate Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) at the local level. Further, all LDRRMCs are to undertake preparedness measures based on Operations LISTO.
3. Strengthen risk communication and localize the warning to communities within respective areas of responsibility;
4. Ensure adherence to the NDRRMC's guidelines on COVID-19 Preparedness Measures for the anticipated rainy season;
5. Conduct of early and immediate pre-emptive evacuation, instead of a reactionary evacuation, to not only ensure the protection of the communities but the safety of the responders as well. Prioritize areas considered as highly vulnerable to flooding, landslide, and storm surge.
6. Conduct early suspension of work and classes as necessary.
7. Issuance and strict implementation of no sail policy in areas expected to be affected by the weather disturbance, and constant monitoring of coastal areas for compliance

- of all fishing vessels and privately owned seacrafts.
8. Continued observance of COVID-19 safety protocols throughout the preparedness and response operations.
 9. RDRRMC Member Agencies and LDRRMCs are required to submit their Situational Report regularly, highlighting the latest situation update, preparedness measures, summary of damages and response needs, to the RDRRM Operations Center thru email address ocd4_mimaropa@yahoo.com.

SUBJECT : PREPARATIONS FOR THE LOW-PRESSURE AREA (LPA) EAST SOUTHEAST OF SURIGAO DEL SUR AND SHEAR LINE


Based on the Weather Updating conducted on 05 April 2022, at 10:00 AM, the center of the Low-Pressure Area was estimated at 180 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.6N, 127.8E).

In this connection, all Chairpersons of RDRRMCS/ OCD Regional Directors are hereby directed to undertake the following preparedness actions in connection with the Low-Pressure Area:

1. Monitor closely the warning and other advisories issued by DOST-PAGASA, DENR-MGB, and other surveillance agencies. Cross validate the current situation with the Doppler radar images, satellite images, and other science-based monitoring and forecasting tools;
2. Initiate Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) at the regional level. Further, coordinate with the DILG for the LDRRMCS to conduct respective local PDRA and undertake preparedness based on Operation LISTO;
3. Strengthen risk communication and localize the warning to communities within respective areas of responsibility;
4. Ensure adherence to the NDRRMC's guidelines on COVID-19 Preparedness Measures for the anticipated rainy season; and
5. Submit regular RDRRMC Situation Report, as needed, highlighting the current situation, preparedness measures, summary of damages, and response needs, to the NDRRM Operations Center.
