

NEGOSYO CENTER



- ✓ The Negosyo Center Program is responsible for promoting ease of doing business and facilitating access to services for Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). Republic Act No. 10644 otherwise known as the “Go Negosyo Act,” seeks to strengthen MSMEs to create more job opportunities in the country.

- ✓ Negosyo Centers are found in strategic areas convenient for existing and would-be entrepreneurs, such as DTI offices, Local Government Units (LGU), academe, Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), and malls.

Are you qualified?

- ✓ Any business entity or enterprise involved in the production, processing or manufacturing of products or commodities, including agro-processing, trading and services;
- ✓ With assets not exceeding Php 3 million (excluding land);
- ✓ Excluding those rendered by anyone, who is duly licensed by the government after having passed a government licensure examination, in connection with the exercise of one's profession.



P3 CARES



- ✓ Bayanihan CARES is an **interest-free** and **collateral-free** financing program that aims to assist micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) recover from the adverse effects of the pandemic. The borrower MSMEs will only need to pay a one-time service fee, which is set at a maximum of eight (8) percent for a 4-year loan term.



P3 CARES FOR TRAVEL



- ✓ Through the DOT and SB Corporation's CARES for TRAVEL program, **tourism-engaged MSMEs** will have access to **zero interest, no-collateral loans**. The borrower MSMEs will only need to pay a one-time service fee, which is set at a maximum of eight (8) percent for a 4-year loan term.



P3 HEROES



- ✓ Helping the Economy Recover thru OFW Enterprise Start-ups (HEROES) is a program of the National Government that provides an opportunity for **displaced, repatriated, or returning OFWs** to rebuild their lives here in the Philippines by helping them establish their start-up businesses.




Shared Service Facilities

LIVELIHOOD SEEDING PROGRAM – NEGOSYO SERBISYO SA BARANGAY



- ✓ A program of DTI that allows a wider reach of business development assistance by bringing government services closer to the people through the provision of **livelihood starter kits**.



PANGKABUHAYAN SA PAGBANGON AT GINHAWA PROGRAM



- ✓ DTI aims to provide assistance package for **victims of fire, typhoons, and other calamities** nationwide.



COMPREHENSIVE AGRARIAN REFORM PROGRAM



- ✓ The program is in support of the government's thrust towards the economic development of the countryside through **rural industrialization**.



COMPREHENSIVE AGRARIAN REFORM PROGRAM



- ✓ It has the following objectives:
- Tap the **manpower of farmer - beneficiaries** and their immediate families for MSME development, thereby increasing their household incomes and stimulating industrial activity in their communities; and
 - To harness the landowners' land compensation toward investments in viable agro-industrial projects in their respective communities



SAFETY SEAL CERTIFICATION



- ✓ A voluntary certification scheme that affirms that an establishment is **compliant with the minimum public health standards** set by the government and uses or integrates its contact tracing with StaySafe.ph.



SAFETY SEAL CERTIFICATION



The DTI issues the Safety Seal for **supermarkets, groceries, convenience stores, membership shopping clubs, construction supply/hardware stores, logistics service providers, barbershops and salons, and service and repair shops.**
