In line with the implementation of the Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Management Program (CMEMP), this Bureau will be conducting a three-day consultation for updating and completion/validation of data pertaining to Marine Protected Area Network Establishment and Strengthening. The said consultation will be held physically in **Metro Manila** (venue to be determined) on **19-23 September 2022** (inclusive of travel time).

The objectives of the said activity are as follows:

- 1. To present the importance and current status of MPANs (listing and roadmap);
- 2. To identify issues and challenges in implementing MPANs;
- 3. To present and review steps in establishing MPAN;
- 4. To refine MPAN thresholds/ target activities as well as costing;
- 5. To rollout MPAN online group and database.

As such, may we request for the participation of the concerned CMEMP-MPAN staff from your respective Region, to wit:

- 1. One (1) Regional CMEMP-MPAN focal;
- 2. One (1) CMEMP-MPAN focal from the PENRO/ CENRO/ PAMO (<u>implementing</u> <u>unit/ facilitating the MPAN activities/ where MPAN budget is lodged</u>)

Further, the CMEMP focals are advised to prepare the following for ease of discussion during the workshop:

- 1. 10-15 minute presentation on the status of MPANs per region as well as issues encountered (*template to be provided*);
- 2. Shapefiles/technical description of the MPA networks;
- 3. Compiled soft copy of MOVs (e.g. signed MOA, management plan, etc); and
- 4. Updated MPAN Status matrix (template to be provided).
