Respectfully referred herein letter sent thru email dated 21 July 2022, addressed and coursed thru the Office of the DENR Secretary and endorsed to the DENR Action Center/Hotline from **CENRO Sablayan Employees** pertaining to their complaint against CENR Officer Anastacio A. Santos and his alleged weak leadership, management, impartiality, arrogance, corruption, misuse of public funds, and lack of integrity as a public servant. Accordingly, CENRO Santos was impartial/unfair in selecting Forest Protection Officer (FPO) in the said Office; showed misbehavior and arrogance during some meetings thru abuse of power and humiliation of personnel without justifiable reasons; exhibited corruption thru anomalous collection of money from Travelling Expenses Voucher claim (TEV) and solicitation from ECC holders in the Municipality of Sablayan during tree planting and other office activities; violation of DENR existing standards thru the concreting of Office grounds and parking without consultation to the DPWH despite being part of the national highway; and etc. With these, the complainants call for the removal of CENRO Anastacio from his position in order to ease the burden of the said employees, which merits your appropriate action, consistent with existing laws, rules and regulations.

Kindly inform directly the complainant of action taken in this regard furnishing the HEA and this Office for monitoring/reference purposes. Expeditionary action is requested in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 11032, otherwise known as the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018 as implemented and enforced by the Anti-Red Tape Authority. Please be reminded that failure to timely respond to the public's concern shall be ground for administrative sanctions under existing laws and regulations.
