
REFERENCE: Attached NDRRMC Memorandum No. 200 Series 2022 entitled "Maintaining of RDRRMOC Blue Alert Status ICOW Tropical Depression ROSAL" addressed to all concerned NDRRMC Member – Agencies and Regional DRRM Councils.

Per Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 3 issued on December 10, 2022, 11:00 PM by DOST-PAGASA, the center of the eye of Tropical Depression "ROSAL" was estimated based on all available data 355 km East Northeast of Infanta, Quezon or 290 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (15.8 °N, 124.8 °E). It has a maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 55 km/h, and is moving Northward at 10 km/h.

In this regard, the alert status at the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (RDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to **BLUE ALERT**. Thus, continuous coordination and monitoring is heightened effective December 10, 2022 in connection with Tropical Depression "ROSAL".

**SUBJECT : Maintaining of NDRRMOC Blue Alert Status ICOW
TD "ROSAL"**


Based on the Weather Update re Tropical Depression (TD) "ROSAL" conducted on 10 December 2022 at 1:00 PM and Tropical Cyclone Bulletin issued by DOST-PAGASA at 11:00 AM, 10 December 2022, the center of Tropical Depression "ROSAL" including those from Daet Doppler Weather Radar was estimated based on all available data at 110 km North Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes or 315 km East of Infanta, Quezon (14.5 °N, 124.6 °E). It has a maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 55 km/h, and is moving northwestward at 20 km/h. Signal no. 1 is currently raised on the provinces of Catanduanes, eastern portion of Camarines Sur, and eastern portion of Albay.

In this regard, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to BLUE Alert. Thus, continuous coordination and monitoring is heightened effective 10 December 2022 in connection with TD "ROSAL".
