Greetings from LGU-San Vicente. Hope you are doing well.

This request is additional data verification to be used in the Comprehensive Land and Water Use Plan 2021-2029.

In relation to the subject above, we used in the past years the Cadastral Survey of 1988 for the land areas of 10 barangays of San Vicente, Palawan totalling to 165,797.6525 hectares or 1,657.9765 square kilometers. But in the PSA Population Census 2020, they based the population density of San Vicente, Palawan to their sourced from Cadastral survey(certified and provided to the DBM) from LMB, DENR, as of December 2013, which totalling only to 1,462.94 square kilometer. We were also confused because based on our actual records (shape files), the total land area was neither tied to the Cadastral Survey of 1988 nor the Cadastral Survey from LMB, DENR.

Attached herewith is the breakdown of land areas of barangays of San Vicente, Palawan indicated in the municipality CLWUP 2009-2020.
