This pertains to the various Special Budget Requests under the IPAF-SAGF for FY 2022 that we have received from your respective Regions in compliance to BMB Memorandum dated 21 September 2021 on the call for submission of proposals to be funded under the IPAF-SAGF.

Please be informed that the BMB IPAF Review Committee has already deliberated the said proposals on 26 January 2022 pursuant to BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2021-03 on the *Guidelines* on the use of Protected Area Retained Income Account (PA-RIA), Special Account in the General Fund (SAGF), and Protected Area Trust Receipts (PA-TR) and providing the criteria for the allocation of funds under the IPAF-SAGF in the National Treasury.

Following the said guidelines and in consideration of the FY 2022 GAA, the BMB Review Committee has identified the following protected areas with the corresponding allocation as priority for funding under the IPAF-SAGF.
