This pertains to the meeting called by the OCD and NDRRMC regarding updates on the initiatives of various government agencies including DENR, in the ongoing response and recovery operations in the areas affected by Typhoon Odette. The meeting was held on January 27, 2022 at 10AM and presided by Undersecretary Ricardo B. Jalal, the Administrator of OCD and Executive Director of NDRRMC.

Based on the said meeting, the following are the agreements/key discussion for you information and appropriate action, particularly item nos.3, 5, 8 and 9, to wit:

5.	Determine the total fund requirement for the recovery of felled trees and processing the donated forest products, fund requirement to be elevated to the NDRRMC, as necessary	DENR
6.	While currently focusing on emergency shelter assistance shall consider in the Rehabilitation and Recovery Plan for relocation of people in safe areas	NDRRMC

 Submit consolidated report on the status of operations of mini-sawmills. To include total number of board feet (volume) and number of mobile/mini-sawmills deployed, among others 	DENR
 Facilitate the possible reproduction and deployment of additional "mini-sawmill on wheels". Estimated cost to be identified by DENR and for funding, OCD to look into the use of donated funds 	OS-OCD, OCD ROS, DENR
10. Coordinate with PCA 8 regarding the deployment of chainsaws. Further, PCA 8 manifested that based on experience in ST Yolanda response, chainsaws for coconut trees are preferred by the operators than circular saws	OCD R8
 Prepare a consolidated report from PCA, DENR, AFP, OCD Ros on this initiatives for submission to OP 	OS-OCS

In this regard, you are hereby instructed to perform the above-cited activities required of the DENR, in coordination with concerned LGUs and National Government Agencies, and submit your report to this Office within 10 days upon receipt of this memorandum, for monitoring, evaluation and consolidation. The report shall include, among others, the accomplishments of the Region with photographs, including the fund requirement needed for the recovery of felled trees and processing of these forest products, for submission to NDRRMC and OCD for possible funding.

Further, the DENR Region 13 is advised to submit the estimated cost of the fabrication of "mini-sawmill on wheels" that can be duplicated by DENR Regions 7, 8 and MIMAROPA to be used in the processing of the typhoon damaged trees, confiscated and turned-over wood materials for the victims of Typhoon Odette.
