MIMAROPA REGION FOR CY 2021**

This is in connection with your undated memorandum and received by our Office on February 11, 2022 regarding the above-mentioned subject.

Please be informed, that within the jurisdiction of CENRO Quezon, Palawan there are two (2) POs awarded with CBFM-CARP Project with nutrition related programs and activities in CY 2021, to wit:

1. The Isugod Uplanders Association, Incorporated (IUAI) awarded the CBFM-CARP Project on July 13, 2020 entitled "Rubber Plantation Intercropped with Fruit Trees and Vegetable Gardening" covering an area of forty five (45) hectares located at Barangay Isugod, Quezon, Palawan. The PO planted three thousand nine hundred twenty seven (3,927) banana and vegetables such as eggplant, pole sitaw, ampalaya, squash and upo as additional source of their food and income.
2. The Tagbisay Upland Farmers Association Incorporated (TUFAI) awarded the CBFM-CARP Project on May 31, 2021 entitled "Agroforestry, Fuelwood and Timber Production" covering an area of fifty (50) hectares located at So. Boong, Barangay Dumanguena, Narra, Palawan. A total of five hundred (500) pineapple suckers, five hundred (500) papaya seedlings, three hundred thirty (330) banana suckers and five hundred (500) cassava cuttings were produced by the PO.

However, last December 15, 2021, the TUFAl nursery and plantation area were affected by Typhoon Odette. A total of One thousand (1,000) agri-silvi crops were totally impaired/damaged.

As of this date, the PO started to produce/raise the damaged agri-silvi crops and preparing for the plantation establishment.


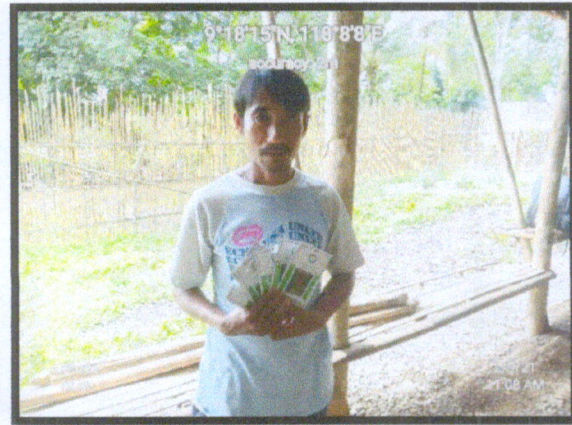
