Consistent with the directives of the Department to utilize the existing monitoring and reporting system, to resolve the issues on discrepancies of reports on the apprehension, seizure, and confiscation of undocumented forest products including conveyances, tools, and implements from the DENR Field Offices, and pursuant to the Memorandum of instructions to use the Electronic Filing and Monitoring System (e-FMS) in generating those reports dated 03 August 2020 and 29 June 2021 signed by the then Undersecretary for Field Operations, Enforcement and Muslim Affairs and Assistant Secretary for Enforcement, respectively, you are hereby instructed to continue the use of “e-FMS” for the recording of the illegal logging and wildlife cases. Submit the report of compliance to this instruction or justification of non-compliance within seven (7) days upon receipt of this Memorandum. The Department would like to have access on all field reports, any time and anywhere and get uniform and standard data on apprehension, seizure, and confiscation of undocumented forest products including conveyances, tools and implements including status of criminal complaints/ cases. Currently, the process of consolidating field reports is manually done which is simply tedious and time consuming. Besides, field reports come in different formats, different units of work measurement (UWM), no remarks on the status, etc., that somehow contributes to discrepancies in the reports.

In view hereof, in order to rectify this, you are hereby instructed, effective immediately, to continue using the "E-Filing and Monitoring System (e-FMS) for Illegal Logging and Illegal Wildlife Cases" until such time that a new system is adopted.

For any problems encountered in activating "e-FMS" accounts, you may coordinate with the DENR Knowledge and Information Systems "e-FMS" administrator in the Department.
