Dear Sir/Madam:

This refers to the continuing implementation of the Cabinet Cluster on Climate Change Adaptation, Mitigation, and Disaster Risk Reduction (CCAM-DRR) Roadmap for 2018 to 2022, and the Risk Resiliency Program (RRP) - Program Convergence Budgeting (PCB) for FY 2023.

Pursuant to Executive Order 120, s. 2020, the Task Force Build Back Better (TFBBB) identified areas that bore the brunt of Typhoons Rolly and Ulysses (TFBBB1), which are namely: the Cagayan River Basin (Region II), Marikina River Basin (Region IV-A, NCR) and Bicol River Basin (Region V). Further, DENR Special Order 2022-23, designated all Regional Executive Directors (REDs) as Task Force Leads in their respective regions. Said Regional Task Force Leads shall be responsible for convening and coordinating with regional counterparts of Agencies designated as Head and Members of each of the six (6) Key Result Areas (KRAs) of the TFBBB. For Typhoon Odette (TFBBB2), Regions IV-B, VI, VII, VIII, X, and CARAGA are identified as harder-hit areas.

As such, there is a need to adjust 2022 WFPs to include TFBBB2 rehabilitation and recovery measures, continue PAPs for TFBBB1, and **identify proposed Programs & Projects under the Risk Resiliency Program (RRP) for 2023, and submit duly accomplished Program Convergence Budgeting (PCB) forms.**

May we invite you and/or your representative/s for a meeting on **Tuesday, February 15, 2022, from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM** regarding the preparation of the Risk Resiliency Program Convergence Budget for Fiscal Year 2023. This activity aims to:

1. Discuss the identified priority investments in the target provinces¹, major urban centers², and respective TFBBB1 and TFBBB2 priority provinces for 2023;
2. Discuss other ongoing/proposed Programs, Activities, Projects (PAPs) to support Roadmap implementation of the cluster member-agencies for 2022-2023; and
3. Provide guidance on accomplishing the prescribed PCB form #1 and BP form 202-A for submission to the secretariat.
