The Tree Hugging Movement is a passionate action towards the protection and conservation of forests. The movement originated in the 1970s in Northern India known as the "Chipko Movement" which saved the forests by emphasizing the interdependence of humans and the environment. Furthermore, tree hugging has a number of health benefits. Study shows that hugging a tree increases levels of the hormone that is responsible for the calmness and emotional well-being of a person. Hugging a tree and spending time around trees can lower blood pressure and heart rates, improve immunity, and reduce stress and anxiety levels.




