The Climate Change Commission in collaboration with the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) is inviting representatives to the **IPPU and Waste GHG Inventory Trainings** on January 17-21 and January 25-28, 2022, at 8:30A.M to 11:30A.M, respectively. The training is in support to the preparation of the 2015 and 2020 National GHG Inventories as inputs to the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC) and the first Biennial Update Report (BUR).

These trainings aim to enhance institutional capacities of government agencies on reporting of GHG inventories under the UNFCCC and thus improving the quality of the

sectoral inventories they will produce consistent with the IPCC guidelines and principles and in compliance with UNFCCC transparency requirements.

Further, the representatives to the training shall be expected to eventually assist in providing the needed data for the sectoral GHG inventories mentioned in future requests.
