Respectfully submitted to that office is the partial inventory of felled and uprooted naturally grown trees including some logs swept away by floods down to the lowland and coastal areas. These are located along roads, plazas, barangay centers, schools and riverbanks which are within timberland and some alienable and disposable lands and not private or titled lands.

Partial report from the two (2) barangays (Brgy. Binduyan and Langogan) of Puerto Princesa City disclosed a total of 1,003 felled, uprooted trees and some logs of different species composed mostly of naturally grown trees corresponding to a total volume of 1,980.499 cu meters. Said trees and logs are being requested by the barangay concerned to be utilized and disposed for the construction and repair of houses which were partially and totally damaged by typhoon "Odette" including repair of barangay centers, schools and other government infrastructures.

In view of the above, requesting further clearance and guiding as to the proper utilization and disposition of same to benefit the affected families in order for them, to rebuild and construct their damaged houses for immediate shelter and the conversion of tops and branches into charcoal or other novelty items (souvenirs) that could be source of their livelihood.

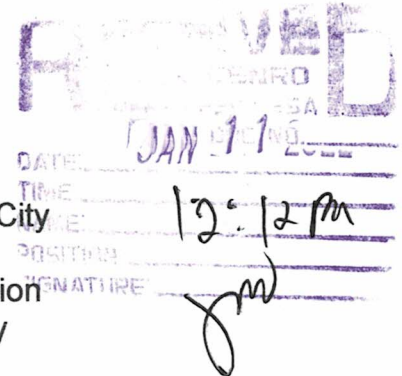

Please be informed that the undersigned DENR-CENRO personnel as team leader of Anilawan FPMS conducted of inventory of felled logs and uprooted trees affected by typhoon oddette within our area of jurisdiction (AOJ).

As per compliance to Special Order No. 2021-62, series of 2021, the creation of composite teams to conduct inspection, inventory and documentation of damaged established NGP sites and fallen/uprooted trees within public lands brought by typhoon oddette in Puerto Princesa City. The undersigned together with the City Environment and Natural Resources Office (City ENRO) and Palawan Counsel for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) jointly conducted inspection, inventory and documentation of felled logs and uprooted trees brought by typhoon oddette within the Barangay Concepcion and Binduyan in this city.

Based on actual inspection/ inventoried over the area, a total of 151 felled/ uprooted trees with an equivalent volume of 173.335 cu.m at Barangay Binduyan and 852 felled/ uprooted trees with an equivalent volume of 1,807.164 cu.m at Barangay Concepcion, Puerto Princesa. The said trees will be utilized for donation to affected community for reconstruction of their houses. Attached are Tally Sheet, Stand and Stock Table, and geo-tagged Pictures for your reference.

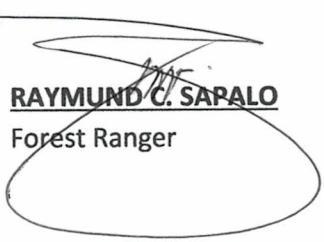

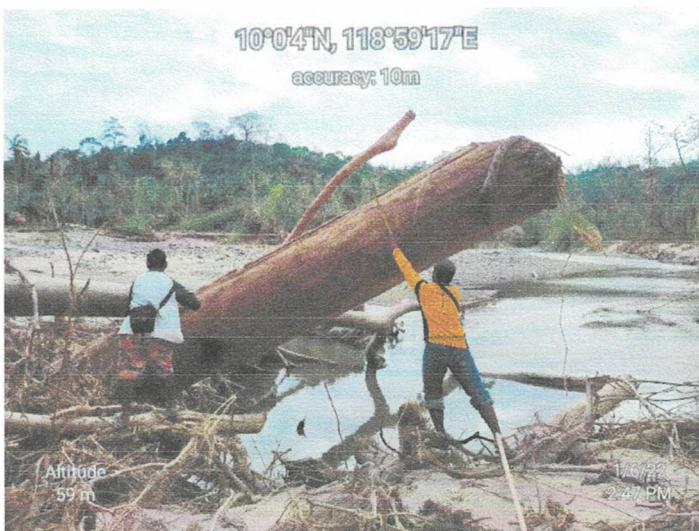
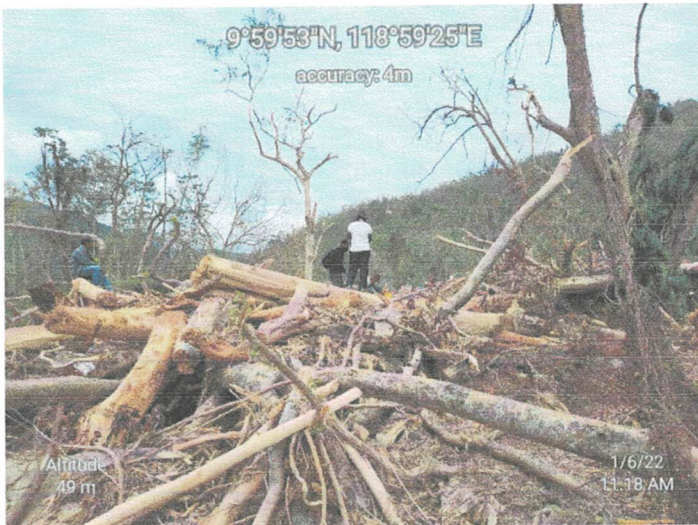
