On August 9, 2021, the DENR-BMB entered into a partnership with the Public-Private Partnership Center (PPPC) for the development of guidelines on public-private partnerships in protected areas pursuant to the NIPAS Act, as amended. The partnership also confirms the PPPC's support to building the capacities of the DENR and concerned implementing agencies in structuring and designing PPPs in protected areas, with main focus on resiliency, safety, as well as conservation and protection of protected areas and natural resources.

Relative to the above, the BMB and PPPC with the assistance of BioFin Project will be conducting a two-week e-learning activity on the basic concepts and processes involved in the PPP which are vital in developing the framework for public-private partnerships in our protected areas. The said activity is composed of five (5) modules and were designed for self-paced learning using short animated videos and document references.
