This is in connection with the Memorandum dated 07 January 2022 issued by the Forest Management Bureau (FMB) regarding the conduct of assessment and submission of report on the damages/impairment loss caused by Typhoon Odette to the established National Greening Program (NGP) sites. Please be reminded of the 30-day reglementary period counted from the occurrence of loss within which the proper accountable officer must file a notice of loss and request for relief of accountability to be recognized by the Commission on Audit (COA). In view of the recent Typhoon Odette which has heavily affected areas in the country, especially those within the jurisdiction of Visayas, Mindanao and Palawan, may this Office respectfully request for the conduct of assessment of the overall damages incurred by the said typhoon to our established NGP Sites and other reforestation projects.

Further, kindly provide an assessment and evaluation report which shall include the total cost/value of damages, estimated number of seedlings/trees damaged, area damaged in hectares, spatial data as well as geotagged photos illustrating the portions of the sites affected, and other pertinent information. For your reference, we have attached the template marked as Annex "A".

Furthermore, all are hereby reminded that reforestation projects damaged or destroyed by force majeure/fortuitous events should be properly reported, and corresponding requests for recognition of impairment loss/derecognition and relief of accountability must be filed before the Commission on Audit (COA) within thirty (30) days after occurrence of the said events.
