PSO Accreditation

QUALIFICATIONS

LEGAL PERSONALITY

The PSO must be registered with any government agency that registers organizations and associations for the purpose of bestowing legal personality.

TRACK RECORD

The PSO must have conducted socioeconomic activities for the past three years immediately preceding the date of its nomination of a PSR.



NON-GOVERNMENT

The PSO must be organized through private initiative.





- Advocacy The RDC secretariat shall conduct advocacy activities to allow wide information dissemination and encourage more private sector participation in the RDC.
- Accreditation The RDC Secretariat shall prepare a list of accredited PSOs in the region. It shall also pre-qualify the PSOs that shall participate in the PSR selection at least one month prior to the actual selection of PSRs.





- Determination of Sectoral and Geographical Allocation. The RDC ex officio members may determine the sectoral and geographic allocation of the one-fourth membership of the private sector in the RDC.
- Nominee and Voter. The RDC secretariat shall request accredited PSOs to submit their nominees and the names of their official voters by accomplishing the Nomination Form and PSR Information Sheet.





• Voting and Proclamation. The RDC secretariat shall prepare the list of official nominees and convene the voters representing the qualified PSOs for the purpose of selecting PSRs to the Council.





- Labor and Basic Sector Representatives. The labor sector and the basic sector representatives shall be selected as follows:
 - Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board MIMAROPA
 - National Anti-Poverty Commission
- **Confirmation**. The RDC ex officio members shall confirm, upon also consideration of the completeness of the proper certifications and clearances submitted, the elected PSRs during the RDC Full Council Meeting to be held after the election of the new set of PSRs.
