Background

Section H4 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Executive Order No. 325, s. 1996, states that the RDC ex officio members may determine the sectoral and geographic allocation of the one-fourth membership of the private sector in the RDC.

With 40 regular voting members of the RDC and with the election of 14 PSRs (one-fourth of the total), the total number of the fully constituted Regional Development Council would be 54.





Based on the thrusts and priorities of the region, the following allocations for PSRs are as follows:

- Geographical representation There shall be two geographical PSRs per province and one geographical PSR for the highly urbanized city of Puerto Princesa City.
- Sectoral representation There shall be PSRs coming from the following sectors: citizen empowerment and good governance; agriculture, fisherfolks and food security; climate change and disaster risk management (GIDA areas); infrastructure and urban development; energy and power; transportation and ICT; science, technology and innovation; social welfare/protection; GAD and women empowerment; and health, nutrition, and population.







14 PSRs in the RDC:



Sectoral or Geographical (11)









- Two basic sector representatives shall also be elected while one labor sector representative shall be designated by the RTWPB.
- To ensure sectoral representation, the RDC PSRs will be equitably distributed to the different sectoral committees of the RDC, as follows:
- ➤ Three PSRs for the Development Administration Committee, one of whom is the labor sector representative
- Four PSRs for the Economic Development Committee, one of whom is a basic sector representative
- > Four PSRs for the Infrastructure Development Committee
- ➤ Three PSRs for the Social Development Committee, one of whom is a basic sector representative
