Respectfully submitted is the apprehension report on illegal logging and cases filed for the month of January CY 2022.

Please be informed that for the month of January 2022 including the apprehensions in previous year which were not included in the FY 2021 annual report, there were a total of 44 apprehensions made in the entire region with almost half in the province of Palawan. The said apprehensions had a total amount of ₱ 511,581.52 for the estimated fair market value of the forest products excluding the market value of the apprehended three (3) units of chainsaw and seven (7) units of conveyance.

Moreover, there were 23 submitted and updated cases filed for this month. The eleven (11) cases filed were still pending at the Office of the Provincial Prosecutor while nine (9) cases were under Court's litigation, one (1) case filed with court decision that the accused was found guilty, one (1) case filed wherein the respondent was released upon posting of bail bond, and one (1) case filed last July 2014 was dismissed as per court order dated Nov. 17, 2021.

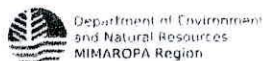

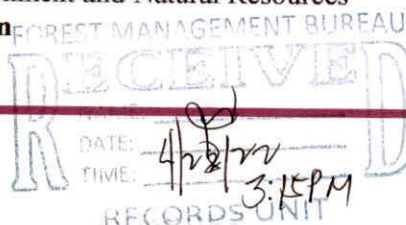

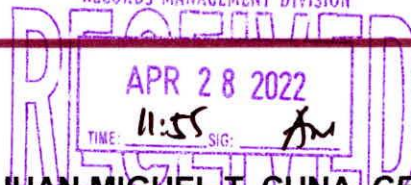
