








RE RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE RBL FISHING CORPORATION
TO COMPENSATE THE DAMAGE ON CORAL REEF BROUGHT
ABOUT BY THE GROUNDING OF F/V MONALINDA 85 AT APO
REEF NATURAL PARK AMOUNTING TO P 2,298,720.00**

brought about by the grounding of F/V Monalinda 85 in Apo Reef Natural Park;





WHEREAS, after considering the reasons cited by Mr. George Tan, the Protected Area Management Board has agreed to be flexible in the mode and terms of payment of the above-cited amount.

WHEREFORE, premises considered and after due deliberation and upon motion of PAMB Grace C. Diamante, duly seconded by PAMB Melchor L. Quiatchon, the Apo Reef Natural Park Protected Area Management Board **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** the following:

- The RBL Fishing Corporation is hereby ordered to settle an administrative fine amounting to Php2,298,720.00 until July 5, 2023, which can be paid in cash monthly or a 30-footer high-speed watercraft with 115 Horse Power Outboard Engine to Apo Reef Natural Park- Protected Area Management Office until December 31, 2022;
- The RBL Fishing Corporation is given seven (7) days to respond to this Resolution and request and propose for staggered payment/settlement of the administrative penalty which shall not exceed July 5, 2023;

FINALLY RESOLVED that copy of this Resolution be provided to RBL Fishing Corporation for their compliance, and DOTr Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), the DA Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) for their information.


