RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 008 SERIES OF 2020 RE RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE ATIENZA INTERISLAND FERRIES, INC. TO COMPENSATE THE DAMAGE TO CORAL REEF, MEASURING 463.762 SQUARE METERS, AMOUNTING TO FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR PESOS (PHP5,565,144.00) CAUSED BY THE GROUNDING OF M/V STAR SAN CARLOS AT APO REEF NATURAL PARK, SABLAYAN, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO ON MAY 10, 2020

WHEREAS, the Apo Reef Natural Park passed a Resolution No. 2020 - 008, Series of 2020 "RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE ATIENZA INTERISLAND FERRIES, INC. TO COMPENSATE THE DAMAGE TO CORAL REEF, MEASURING 463.762 SQUARE METERS, AMOUNTING TO FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR PESOS (PHP5,565,144.00) CAUSED BY THE GROUNDING OF M/V STAR SAN CARLOS AT APO REEF NATURAL PARK, SABLAYAN, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO ON MAY 10, 2020" last March 13, 2020;

WHEREAS, after two (2) administrative hearings on May 13, 2020 and July 8, 2020 both of which were duly attended by Atlanda Atlanda Atlanda the legal 2020 both of which were duly attended by Atty. Yolando Atienza, the legal counsel of the Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc., the former counter-offered an amount of Php200,000.00 in their letter dated July 8, 2020;

WHEREAS, after deliberation and analysis by the Board of the reasons stipulated in the counter offer Land analysis by the Board of the reasons stipulated in the counter-offer letter of Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc., the Board of the reasons Board resolved to reduce the fine by 50% Board resolved to reduce, as humanitarian consideration, the fine by 50%

WHEREAS, the Apo Reef Natural Park Protected Area Management Office issued letter dated India 22, 2020 issued letter dated July 22, 2020 to Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc officially informing the latter of the reduced fine amounting to Php2,782,572.00 and further offered to settle the administrative fine either in cash or in kind;

WHEREAS, the Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc. insisted in their letter dated

WHEREAS, a Special PAMB Meeting was called on July 6, 2022 duly attended by Mr. Silverio Atienza and Atty. Yolando Atienza of Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc. which carefully deliberated the administrative case at

WHEREFORE, premises considered and after due deliberation and upon motion of PAMB Grace C. Diamante, duly seconded by PAMB Melchor L. Quiatchon, the Apo Reef Natural Park Protected Area Management Board RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED the following;

- The Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc. is hereby ordered to settle an administrative fine amounting to Php2,782,572.00 until December 31, 2022, which can be paid either in cash or in kind, broken down as
 - Purchase and delivery of one (1) 30-footer highspeed watercraft, double Yamaha Engine 115 Horsepower, fiber coated hull;
 - 2. Purchase and delivery of one (1) Monolithic Solid Fiber Glass Outrigger Boat, 6 Cylinder, 6D14 Engine
 - 3. Maintenance activities and supplies
- The Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc. is given seven (7) days to respond to Resolution and request and propose for staggered payment/settlement of the administrative penalty which shall not exceed

FINALLY RESOLVED that copy of this Resolution be provided to Atienza Interisland Ferries, Inc. for their compliance, and DOTr Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) for their information.
