

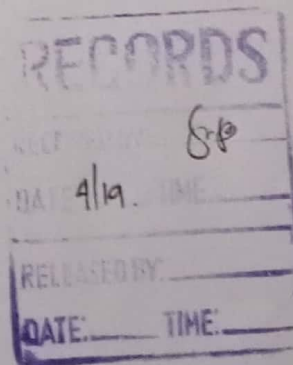


SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF REPORTS ON THE QUARTELY MONITORING

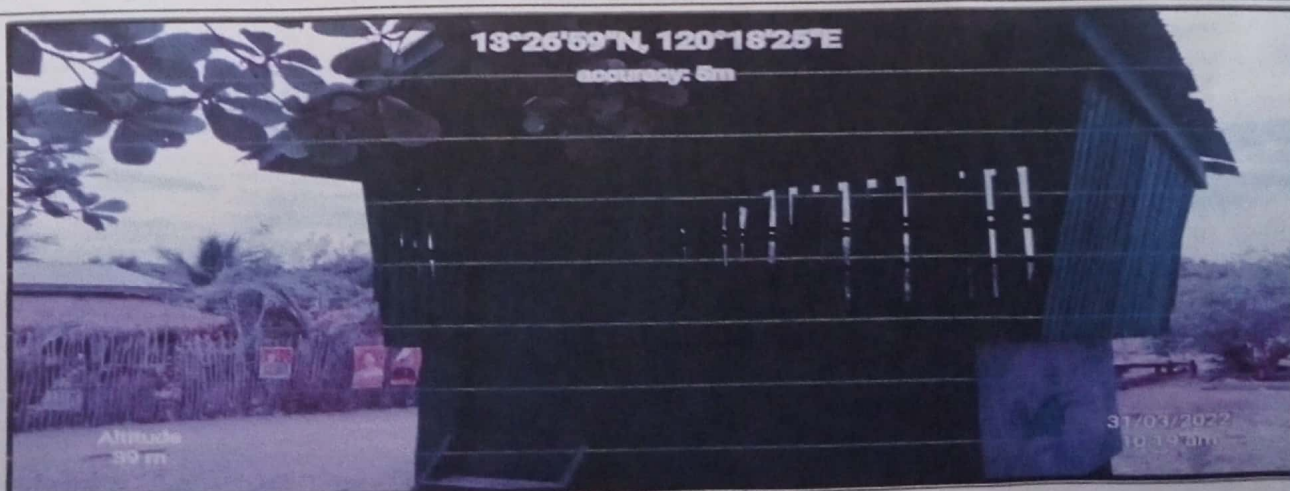
