- Conduct tourism rapid assessments and Gap/Needs Analysis in the communities of Brooke's Point, Palawan, San Jose and Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro, and Bulalacao and Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro
- Invite Regional Line Agencies (RLAs) on scheduled site validation for identification of interventions based on respective mandates and projects
