This pertains to the verbal instruction of OIC-CENRO Rodney G. Verian to conduct inspection at Scottland, Inc. Sitio, Tandul, Brgy. Bintuan, Coron, Palawan.

Please be informed that on June 24, 2022, the team composed of DENR personnel together with some members of Sagip Coron led by Mr. Rodolfo Cadampog coordinated first to the barangay before proceeding to the area. Barangay Kagawad Ricardo Balbutan and Barangay Kagawad Romy Alvarez accompanied the team.

Engr. John Bryan Amado of Scottland Inc. assisted us in the conduct of said inspection.

Scottland Inc. has a total FLAGT area of 16. 3 hectares. The Forest Land Use Agreement for Tourism Purposes was issued on December 3, 2015 (FLAGT No. 01-2015) and will expire on December 2, 2040. The Environmental Compliance Certificate was also approved on June 14, 2014 Bearing No. ECC-4B-1206-0084. Likewise, the corresponding SEP clearance was also issued on September 28, 2012.

The proponent has on-going development of 4.6 hectares based on reading of Global Positioning System (GPS). There are twenty three (23) on-going structures, twenty (20) are intended for guest/visitors which includes the receiving area, cafeteria, canteen, swimming pool, jacuzzi, clinic, spa etc. While the other structures are STP, desalination and siltation/soil erosion mitigating structures.

The Project area was already fenced with cyclone wire on the three (3) sides and open at the beach front.

During the inspection, Mr. Rodolfo Cadampog said that he saw the SEP clearance of Scottland Inc. that the project area has only a total of 4-5 hectares. Engr. John Bryan Amado asked him if he can give him a copy of the said SEP Clearance but cannot provide any. However, on the SEP clearance the area is not indicated. But on the ECC and FLAgT it is clearly stated that it covers 16.3 hectares.

No observed quarrying activities except cut and fill since the terrain is hilly. Mitigation measures on some part are already constructed to avoid soil erosion.

Records of this office, showed that the Proponent is religiously paying their annual rental and submitted their annual accomplishment report for CY 2021.

#### I. CONDITIONS

#### ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT.

The proponent shall strictly implement the following mitigating, enhancement, and rehabilitating measures:

- 1. That green buffer zones and tree planting shall be established within and along the periphery of the project site to help attenuate noise levels, abate heat and absorb some pollutant emissions. The proponent shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the concerned DENR-Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office in the implementation of the tree planting activity. The tree planting is one of the recommended activities in compliance with the government's commitment to the Kyoto Protocol Agreement;
- 2. That the proponent shall strictly manage all external, traffic problems, excessive surface runoff, dust, soil erosion, accidental spillage and health hazards identified in the Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) Report and, in case of emergency episodes, appropriate response activities shall be immediately undertaken for the protection of the workers/ personnel, host and nearby communities and the receiving environment;
- That an effective Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Plan shall be implemented in all phases of the project including communication of environmental risks of the project implementation;
- 4. That a Social Development Program (SDP) shall be implemented for the personnel/workers, host barangay and affected communities which shall cover livelihood training and employment, including assistance in the setting-up of a social development welfare fund for health, education, credit facilities/cooperatives that will ensure the participation of youth and women;
- 5. That preservation and easement retention of natural drainage/waterways shall be undertaken and should conform with the provisions of the DENR Administrative Order No. 97-05 (Procedures in the Retention of Areae within certain distances along the Banks of Rivers, Streams, and Shores of Seas, Lakes and Oceans for Environmental Protection). If disturbed, a replacement drainage system shall be constructed within two (2) months from the disturbance:
- That the solid waste management scheme as provided in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) shall be continuously implemented from the start of the project operation;

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

Further administrative conditions for the grant of this Certificate shall be strictly complied:

7. That the proponent shall religiously comply with the applicable provisions of P.D. 1586 (Philippine Environmental Impact Statement System), R.A. 9275 (Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004), R.A. 9003 (Ecological and Solid Waste

8. That the proponent shall set-up a competent Environmental Unit and shall be duly accredited by this Office in accordance with DAO No. 26, series of 1992 (Appointment/Designation of Pollution Control Officers);

The Environmental Unit shall be integrated in the proponent's organizational chart to handle all environment related aspects of the project implementation in addition to the monitoring requirements as specified in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP)/Environmental Monitoring Plan (EMOP) and other environmental commitments such as but not limited to the following:

8.1 Monitor actual project impacts vis-à-vis the predicted impacts and management measures in the IEE Report.

8.2 Ensure that all post-assessment permits/clearances from other concerned

government agencies are secured and in place.

8.3 Regular submission of a semi-annual ECC Compliance Monitoring Report (on or before January 15 and July 15 of each year the project is operational) provided with supporting documents and in accordance with the prescribed format stipulated in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of P.D. 1586.

8.4 Submit a quarterty monitoring report using the prescribed format of the Self-

Monitoring Report (SMR) pursuant to DAO 2003-27.

- 8.5 Submit an Abandonment Plan two (2) months prior to the abandonment activities. It shall include rehabilitation measures/clean-up, costs, remediation of areas possibly contaminated with toxic/hazardous substances and presentation of options on proposed alternative projects in the area.
- That the proponent shall allocate ample budget for the implementation of the proposed mitigating/enhancement measures during the operation and abandonment phases of the project;
- 10. That health and sanitation practices shall be observed in all phases of the project and safety & personal protection equipment/devices shall always be provided to all employees/workers within the premises of the project site to prevent health and occupational hazards;
- 11. That a billboard containing this message: "Notice to the Public, This THE PEAK CORON BAY PROJECT of MR. RICHARD UY has been issued an Environmental Compilance Certificate (ECC-R4B-1206-0084) by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Environmental Management Bureau MIMAROPA Region on installed at all entry and exit points and in the perimeter of the project site facing the road to inform the general public within thirty (30) days from receipt of the ECC;
- 12. That a copy of the ECC shall be posted in a conspicuous location at the field office of the project site clearly visible to the public and shall be adequately framed or otherwise protected against damage and at the barangay bulletin board of the host barangay(s) within thirty (30) days from receipt of the ECC.
- 13. That any authorized DENR-EMB personnel, with proper identification card and travel/mission order, shall be allowed unconditional access to conduct an on-the-spot inspection and monitoring to the project without the need for prior notice to the proponent to oversee compliance to the ECC;

#### **II. RESTRICTIONS**

- That no other activities shall be undertaken other than what was stipulated in the IEE Report. Should there be an expansion of the project beyond the project description, construction of other structures beyond those stated in the IEE Report or any change in the activity or location, shall be made subject to a new Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) requirements;
- 2. That all appropriate construction, operational and resource-use permits/clearances from other national and local government agencies concerned (i.e. PMRB, PNP, LGUs, DPWH, DOH, NWRB, HLURB, MGB, DA, DAR, DOLE, DTI, etc.) shall be secured pertaining to the implementation of the project. Likewise, the proponent shall notify this Office of the reckoning date of project operation;
- That an Engi seering Geological and Geo-hazard Assessment (EGGA) shall be conducted within the project sire and the report shall be submitted to Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau, Region IV-B copy furnished this Office within sixty (60) days upon receipt hereof;
- That the proponent shall plant an equivalent area of the project with appropriate tree species and shall coordinate with PENRO/CENRO concerned for area identification;
- That in case of transfer of ownership/management of this project, these same conditions and restrictions shall apply and the transferee shall be required to notify this Office concerned within fifteen (15) days as regards to the transfer of ownership/management; and
- That the proponent (Mr. Richard Uy) shall be jointly and severally accountable for any misrepresentation and failure to state material information in the submitted documents.

The conditions stipulated in this Certificate shall be deemed final within fifteen (15) days from receipt hereof and all conditions and restrictions set forth above shall be complied with by the herein grantee. This ECC is deemed expired if not implemented within five (5) years from the date of issuance and the proponent shall have to apply for a new ECC if it intends to pursue the project.

Non-compliance with any of the provisions of this certificate shall be a sufficient cause for the cancellation or suspension of this certificate and/or imposition of a fine in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP50,000.00) for every violation thereof.

The ECC component is hereby amended as follows:

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

That this Certificate is valid only for the operation of The Lind Resort and Spa Project covering a total area of Sixteen hectares (16 has.) covered by Tax Declaration Nos. 008-1241-1; 008-1222-A; 008-1223-A; 008-1224-A; 008-1225-A; 008-1226-A; and 008-1227-A located at Sitio Tandol, Barangay Bintuan, Coron, Palawan. Said Resort and Spa is consisting of the following facilities and amenities as contained in the submitted Project Description Report.

Phase I: 24 units of Pool Villas; 6 Cluster Buildings with 56 total rooms (24 deluxe rooms and 32 standard rooms); Clubhouse; Restaurant/Bar with Gym and/or Recreational facilities; Lap Pool; Beach Development with bar and 2 pools; 18 units of Water Villas; Marina/Breakwater Pier (60mx5m stone pier); Marina Pavillon; VIP Lounge; Administration Building; Golf cart Parking Area; Maintenance Building/Staff Quarters; and Utility structures for STP, Genset, Water storage and Maintenance

Phase II: 6 Cluster buildings for divers; 10 units of Luxury Villas; and Spa Building.

### The following conditions are hereby added:

- That monitoring wells shall be installed and maintained within the project site and identified impact areas, which shall include the following:
  - A semi-annual groundwater quality sampling shall be conducted and the results of
     Cisterns shall be installed to this Office.
  - Cistems shall be installed to minimize the extraction of groundwater for domestic purposes.
- 2. That in support of the concern of the government to phase-out mercury from all possible sources and to address global warming, the proponent shall install

- 3. That the proponent shall establish a carbon sink program or apply/use alternative fuel (i.e. bio-fuel liquefied petroleum gas, etc.) to deal with the reduction program on activities potential to contribute greenhouse gases or global warming.
- 4. The proponer's hall set up the following:
  - a. A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall be entered into by the proponent with the ECC Holders Association to become part of their MMT and in setting up the corresponding Environmental Monitoring Fund (EMF) prior to project implementation;
  - b. A replenishable Environmental Monitoring Fund (EMF) to cover all costs attendant to the operation of the MMT such as conduct meetings, training, sampling and analysis, hiring of technical experts, meals, accommodations, supplies and materials, communication, and transportation.
  - c. The amount and mechanics of the EMF, and the establishment of the MMT shall be determined by the EMB-MIMAROPA Region and the proponent in consultation with stakeholder-communities and other concerned agencies. This MOA shall be submitted to EMB-MIMAROPA within sixty (60) days upon receipt of this Certificate.

Please be informed that all other conditions stipulated in your ECC shall remain in force and effective.

Further, be reminded that any misrepresentation or material falsehood on the submitted documents and non-compliance to the conditions stipulated in the ECC shall be sufficient cause for cancellation of the same. Please submit to this Office your ECC Compliance Monitoring Report semi-annually (on or before 15th of January and July of each year the project is operational) provided with supporting documents and permits/clearances as well as the strict implementation of your updated Environmental Management Plan (EMP) and other environmental commitments.

## FOREST LAND USE AGREEMENT FOR TOURISM PURPOSES (FLAgT) No. 01 - 2015

This AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between:

The REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, through the DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES ("DENR"), with postal address at Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City City, herein represented by its Secretary, RAMON J. P. PAJE, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY,

-and-

SCOTTLAND INCORPORATED, represented by its Executive Vice President, MR. RICHARD A. UY, with postal address at the Penthouse. The Spa Building, No. 80 E. Rodriguez Jr. Avenue, Libis, Quezon City, herein referred to as the SECOND PARTY,

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, under Executive Order No. 192, promulgated on June 10, 1987, the DENR is empowered to exercise supervision and control over the forestlands of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Section 57 of Presidential Decree No. 705, also known as the "Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines", authorizes the special use of forestlands for beneficial purposes which do not impair the forest resources therein;

WHEREAS, after conducting evaluation and assessment, the **SECOND PARTY** has determined that the establishment, development and operation of a Tourism Project in the above-mentioned area is technically and financially feasible;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY has applied for Forest Land Use Agreement for Tourism Purposes (FLAgT) covering Sixteen and 30/100 (16.30) hectares of forestland in Sitio Tandul, Barangay Bintuan, Coron, Palawan in accordance with DENR Administrative Order Nos. 2004-28 dated August 25, 2004 and 2009-16 dated November 25, 2009;

WITNESSES:

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WHEREAS, after review and validation of the application, the FIRST PARTY found that the SECOND PARTY has complied with the requirements for FLAgT:

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the terms and conditions set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

### Area, Purpose and Duration

- I. The FIRST PARTY hereby grants the SECOND PARTY the exclusive right to occupy, manage and develop approximately Sixteen and 30/100 (16.30) hectares of public forestland (the "FLAgT Area") for Tourism Purposes for a period of twenty five (25) years to expire on December 2, 2040, renewable for another twenty-five (25) years, located at Sitio Tandul, Barangay Bintuan, Coron, Palawan, the boundaries of which are shown in the attached map and form as an integral part of this AGREEMENT.
- II. The FLAgT Area shall be confined within the perimeter of the parcel of land described in the attached map. No other parcel of public forestland shall be utilized by the SECOND PARTY without first securing the prior approval of the FIRST PARTY.
- III. The FLAgT Area is a public forestland to the best knowledge and belief of the parties, and the **FIRST PARTY** confirms that based on applicable land classification maps, control' maps, and available records of the DENR, there are no prior existing rights therein granted in favor of third parties. The **FIRST PARTY** shall not be responsible for any loss that the **SECOND PARTY** may suffer in case the FLAgT Area or portion thereof is declared with finality by a competent court or authority as the private property of another, or is found to be covered by a prior existing right.
- IV. The **SECOND PARTY** shall utilize the FLAgT Area only for the purpose for which this **AGREEMENT** is granted. In the event the said area will be used for a different purpose, said use shall be subject to prior approval of the Secretary or his duly authorized representative.
- V. The **SECOND PARTY** shall, within six (6) months from the issuance of this **AGREEMENT**, delineate and mark on the ground the boundaries of the FLAgT Area under the supervision of the DENR. It shall preserve the monuments and other landmarks indicating corners and outlines along the boundaries and within the confines of the FLAgT Area.
- VI. The SECOND PARTY may construct permanent and/or temporary improvements or infrastructure in the FLAgT Area necessary and appropriate for its development for tourism purposes pursuant to the approved CDMP. "Permanent Improvements" refer to access roads, and buildings or structures which adhere to the ground in a fixed and permanent manner. On the other hand, "Temporary Improvements" include those which are detachable from the foundation or the ground introduced by the SECOND PARTY in the FLAgT Area and which the SECOND PARTY may remove or dismantle upon expiration or cancellation of this AGREEMENT. Any substantial deviations or modifications from, and/or additional improvements in, the approved CDMP shall be subject to prior approval of the Regional Director (RD), or his duly authorized representative. Such deviations, modifications or additional improvements shall at all times be consistent with the purpose for which the FLAgT Area is granted under paragraph I hereof.

### Government Share and Performance Bond

- VII. The SECOND PARTY shall pay annual Government Share of Six Hundred Eleven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 611,250.00), Philippine Currency, within thirty (30) days upon approval of this AGREEMENT, and annually thereafter, within the same month that this AGREEMENT is issued based on the zonal value of the nearest commercial zone within the barangay or the nearest adjacent barangay within the Municipality. A revaluation shall be undertaken every five (5) years thereafter depending on the frequency of the zonal valuation being undertaken by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR).
- VIII. The annual Government Share shall be paid by the **SECOND PARTY**, without need of demand, within the same month that this **AGREEMENT** was issued. In case of failure to pay the annual Government Share on the date due, the **SECOND PARTY** shall pay additional charges of 8.33% per month of delay or 100% for one (1) year.
  - IX. The Government Share is non-refundable.
- X. Payment of Government Share after the expiration of this AGREEMENT shall not be construed as an assurance for the renewal thereof.
- XI. As guarantee for the faithful performance of the terms and conditions of this AGREEMENT, and compliance with applicable Forest Laws and Regulations, the SECOND PARTY shall post a Performance Bond of One Million Two Hundred Twenty Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,222,500.00) which is twice the amount of annual Government Share. The Performance Bond may be posted in cash or 50% cash and the other 50% in the form of surety bond with a duration of five (5) years renewable every five (5) years. Provided, that the face value of the surety bond shall be increased by at least 25%. The performance bond shall be posted within three (3) months upon approval of this agreement, pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-28, dated August 25, 2004.

### Obligations of the Second Party

- XII. The **SECOND PARTY** shall immediately secure the required Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) and other necessary permits prior to conduct of any activity in the area.
- XIII. No trees, regardless of species, shall be cut in the FLAgT Area if found within twenty (20) meters from banks of rivers, creeks or streams and of public roads. In case the said 20-meter strip is bereft of trees, the same shall be rehabilitated by the SECOND PARTY.
- XIV. The **SECOND PARTY** shall strictly observe sanitary measures within the FLAgT Area to ensure protection of watershed values;
- XV. The SECOND PARTY shall protect the FLAgT Area from forest fires and other forms of forest destruction.

WATNESSES:

XVI. The **SECOND PARTY** shall protect and conserve unique, rare and endangered flora and fauna, if any, within the FLAgT Area pursuant to existing laws, rules and regulations.

XVII. The **SECOND PARTY** shall not impede, obstruct or prevent the entry and exit through the FLAgT Area of legitimate stakeholders and/or forest users authorized by the DENR.

XVIII. The **SECOND PARTY** shall submit an Annual Report to the RD thru the CENRO concerned copy furnished the FMB Director showing developmental activities undertaken within the FLAgT Area in accordance with the approved CDMP.

XIX. All authorized DENR officials and/or employees shall be allowed by the **SECOND PARTY** to enter and inspect the FLAgT Area for the purpose of monitoring compliance with the terms and conditions of this **AGREEMENT** and the activities authorized under the approved CDMP.

XX. The **SECOND PARTY** shall inform the RD or his duly authorized representative on any changes in the management, ownership or capital stock of the company or corporation or transfer of a majority of the stock or shares of the company or corporation as provided for in PD 705, as amended.

#### Termination

XXI. This **AGREEMENT** may be terminated or cancelled by the **FIRST PARTY**, after giving the **SECOND PARTY** due notice and opportunity to be heard, on any of the following grounds:

- a) Violation of any of its terms and conditions, or failure to comply with the obligations under this AGREEMENT;
- b) In case this **AGREEMENT** was determined, after appropriate proceedings, to have been obtained through fraud, misrepresentation or omission of material facts existing at the time of filing of the application;
- c) Abandonment of the FLAgT Area or failure to utilize the same for the purpose it was granted within the prescribed period of six (6) months without justifiable cause;
- d) Failure to introduce improvements or develop the FLAgT Area as indicated in the CDMP; and
- e) Failure to pay the Government Share and other administrative fees after three (3) consecutive notices after the same had become due and demandable;

XXII. In the event the FIRST PARTY determines that any of the above grounds exist, a notice of breach shall be sent to the SECOND PARTY giving the latter at least fifteen (15) calendar days to submit a written explanation. Before any termination is resorted to, the parties shall meet and exert best efforts to resolve the dispute, except when the grounds refer to items (b) and (c) above. The SECOND PARTY shall be given reasonable time within which to remedy the breach or to implement the agreed remedial measures.

XXIII In case of termination or cancellation of this AGREEMENT due to the fault of the SECOND PARTY, the Performance Bond shall be forfeited in favor of the FIRST PARTY, and the SECOND PARTY shall have no right to claim for reimbursement or compensation of whatever kind for the permanent improvements introduced within the FLAgT Area as defined in paragraph VI hereof. Such improvements, which shall not include the Temporary Improvements referred to in paragraph VI above, shall be forfeited in favor, and become the property, of the FIRST PARTY.

XXIV. Upon termination of this **AGREEMENT**, the **SECOND PARTY** shall be allowed to continue to occupy the FLAgT Area for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days to enable it to remove the Temporary Improvements referred to in paragraph VI, above, and to revert the land to its original condition to the extent possible.

### Ownership and Transfer

The **SECOND PARTY** shall, with respect to its ownership or capital stock, and in relation to the right granted herein to use the public forestland described in the attached map, ensure compliance with the nationality requirement under Article XII, Section 2 of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines, at all times throughout the duration of this **AGREEMENT**. In this regard, the **SECOND PARTY** shall secure the approval of the **FIRST PARTY** or his duly authorized representative in case of transfer of majority of its shares or capital stock after execution of this **AGREEMENT**.

XXVI. The **SECOND PARTY** may transfer this **AGREEMENT** or any rights therein or any assets used therewith, if authorized by the DENR Secretary, subject to the following conditions:

- a) The FLAgT has been in existence for at least three (3) years;
- b) The SECOND PARTY has been faithfully complying with the terms and conditions of the FLAgT including implementation of CDMP;
- c) The transferee has all the qualifications and none of the disqualifications to hold a FLAgT;
- d) The transferee shall assume all the obligations and responsibilities of the transferor specified in the FLAgT, CDMP and ECC.

### Amendment and Renewal

XXVII. That the Parties herein hereby agree to adopt any changes, modifications and amendments to this **AGREEMENT** to ensure its consistency to new guidelines, policies, regulations and Administrative Orders to be issued by the DENR on Forest Land Use Agreement for Tourism Purposes, such as but not limited to management schemes, government grants among others.
