Good day! I would like to follow up on our previous request for data on the Long-tailed Macaques in your region.

The Long-tailed Macaque Project (<https://theltmpproject.org/>) is an international initiative to study the species across its range. We are currently collating data on Long-tailed macaques in captivity in the Philippines to better understand the captive population size and challenges in keeping them.

In line with this, we would like to request the following information on the species from your center/facility:

- Current number of long-tailed macaques in the center /facility
- Origin or source of the macaques (e.g., rescued, voluntary turned over, confiscated)

We intend to use the data to determine possible source locations of Long-tailed Macaques that may eventually end up in the care of rescue centers/facilities. We will also be grateful if you can refer knowledgeable personnel on the challenges of keeping macaques in captivity.
