This is to provide you a copy of the Highlights of the Luzon Cluster Quarterly Meeting held via Zoom on June 23, 2022. The 2nd Quarter Luzon Cluster meeting aimed to present the responses/comments of the concerned bureaus on the issues and concerns raised during the 4th Quarter Luzon Cluster meeting; and present and discuss the selected current and emerging issues submitted by the Regional Executive Directors.

The submitted issues and concerns of the Luzon Cluster had been consolidated. Please note that OASFLV staff compiled eleven (11) issues to be included in the agenda, but two (2) more issues were added during the discussion, thus ended with a total of 13 issues. OASFLV - Clarified that supposedly, ECC inside PA will not be issued unless approved by the PAMB. Thus, the office will make the necessary representation with the EMB as this was also observed in foreshore areas and forestlands where ECC was issued even without the proper tenurial instrument. As a rule of thumb, tenurial instrument must be approved prior to the application of ECC. This issue is similar in Boracay and this should be understood before any development should be undertaken. Possibly, will initiate a meeting to further discuss these processes.	CAR – Explained that Certificate of non- coverage should not be issued in areas within NIPAS. However, there are CNCs granted online. It was suggested that necessary adjustments are required for online program. They added that for the meantime, the areas issued with CNCs have been validated to determine whether the area is outside or within ECA.	CAR – Also confirmed that LAWIN app is incompatible with other devices. Unfortunately, most of the old devices issued are no longer functioning. 	OASFLV - The design could be for multi- level. Moreover, we will note on what the LMB could provide to enlighten everyone on this issue. In addition, Titling may not be a problem but there is a need to comply with the requirements of the other government agencies like LGU.

NCR - There is no specific guidelines in establishing the claim of an individual in the issuance of Survey Authority	NCR – Although there are basic requirements for establishing the claim of an individual, there are also complex cases to be considered in establishing the claims of individual for example, the listed claimant is erroneous or does not exist/cannot be located. The conflict has not escalated to a formal complaint or multiple claimants. It could be the conduct of investigation for survey authority is subjective and the documents presented by the proponent varied. Currently, they are crafting a procedural manual for the conduct of investigation pursuant to ISO standard.	LMB
	CAR - There is a manual for survey and the requirements are included in the manual. So, there is already a specific guideline and everybody can check the procedure regarding land survey. The	

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	process which was highlighted is to first resolve the conflict for multiple claimants and then issue the survey authority for the winning party.	
	OASFOLV - As it was explained, it can be checked to the manual for guidance. Moreover, this issue will then be forwarded to the LMB. Meanwhile, advice the SMD of NCR to visit the provision in the survey manual	
7. CAR - No allotted funds for the conduct of FPIC for NGP areas	provision in the survey manual. CAR - This issue was already discussed in the meeting with NCIP.	N/A
8. CAR- Reclamation of river banks by private individuals	CAR – It was suggested to remove this issue as they have affirmed that this was not a reclamation, instead it is a stock file. Thus, it was agreed to discard this issue.	N/A
9. R3 - Re-establishment of control points/ references and relocation of lots affected by Mt Pinatubo	R3 - This was an issue particularly in towns of Bacolor, Florida Blanca and Porac. After Mt. Pinatubo has erupted, these areas were covered by lahar for a dept of about 30-40 meters. Thus, established control points are gone/missing. Now that it is under mining, the LMS is needing to re- establish the missing mojon. This activity was proposed in the 2022 WFP but unfortunately, it was not included in the approved WFP. Considering this activity is crucial in the identified arcas, they will again propose the said activity for possible inclusion in the 2023 budget. It was emphasized that Dir. Talabis has a positive response on this issue and is willing to provide assistance to resolve the issue. OASFLV – This office will make a follow-up with LMB regarding the request of R3.	LMB
