Anchored on the Values Restoration Program, a soft approach to the government’s anti-corruption initiatives, the School of Statesmanship Module 2 Training seeks to equip government employees and other interested participants with the basic knowledge and skills on dispute resolution inside or outside their offices. It also offers sessions on how to handle labor-related issues including procedures to be followed as well as restorative justice principles to help involved employees reintegrate into the office.

Every participant is entitled to receive corresponding points for ranking, promotion and increments for every hour of training as CRFV is an ALDI of the Civil Service Commission. 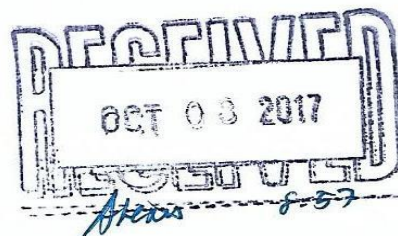
