Dear *OIC RED Claudio*:

This refers to the Office of the Solicitor General's (OSG) letter dated 18 March 2022 as regards the planned filing of a complaint for ejectment and payment of sum of money with prayer for preliminary mandatory injunction against MMC.

It may be recalled that in said letter, we raised and/or inquired the following:

1. certified true or authenticated copies of the necessary documents;
2. updated computation of arrears collectible from 2001 up to the present;
3. environmental violations of MMC, if any, which we may use in (a) the planned complaint for ejectment to support a prayer for temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction, and/or (b) separate case; and
4. the intended DENR representative/signatory of the planned complaint and inputs to said draft, if any.

May we have an update or feedback anent said letter.

Relatedly, may we inform your good office that we took the liberty to inquire with the Department of Transportation (DOTr) the status of the repair and rehabilitation of Balogo Port. The DOTr, through Undersecretary Giovanni Z. Lopez, informed us that Php300 million has indeed been appropriated under the General Appropriations Act; that it has submitted the requisite special Budget Request; and that it awaits the Department of Budget and Management's (DBM) release of the Special Allotment Release Order (SARO). A copy of DOTr's letter dated 04 April 2022 to the OSG is attached for your immediate reference.

If you find it necessary, we can have a strategic meeting (in virtual or electronic form) on the matter, including the possible non-judicial remedies available to the Government.
