Bono-Bono Malihud Bulalacao Community-Based Forest Management Integrated Upland Farmers Producers Cooperative (BMBCB-FMIUFPC) with CBFMA No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2000-16 covering an area of 2,092.25 hectares located in Brgys. Bono-Bono, Malihud, and Bulalacao, all in the municipality of Bataraza, Palawan; and
2. Punang Christian Muslim Native Multipurpose Cooperative (PCMNM-MPC) with CBFMA No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2000-17 covering an area of 1,481.25 hectares located in Brgy. Punang Sofronio Espanola, Palawan.

Both CBFMA holders monitored are compliant with the terms and conditions stipulated in their respective CBFM Agreements.   | This Office recommends for the continuous monitoring and provision of technical assistance particularly on capacity development (e.g., soil and water conservation measures, forest protection, enterprise development, reorganization, and others) in order to sustain their good performance and strengthen the organization of the POs. Provide them with necessary support in networking with other agencies and organizations for additional financial or technical assistance in the implementation of different projects for the development of their CBFM areas. The information particularly the accomplishments of the CBFM-POs should also be encoded and updated in the Enhanced Forestry Information System (eFIS). |
| 2. The two (2) CBFMA holders, BMBCB-FMIUFPC and PCMN-MPC), are expiring within the next three (3) years and both are recommended for the conduct of performance evaluation.   | <p>1. 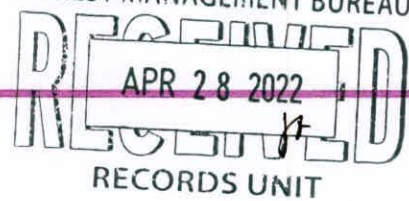

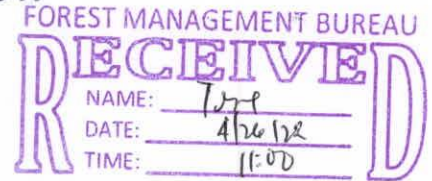

Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated December 26, 2021 of PENRO Palawan, submitting the annual report for CY 2021 on the monitoring and evaluation of two (2) CBFM areas within the jurisdiction of CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan.

Per report, the Bono-Bono Malihud Bulalacao Community Based Forest Management Integrated Upland Farmers Producers Cooperative (BMBCBFMIUFPC) located in Bataraza, Palawan and Punang Christian Muslim Native Multi-Purpose Cooperative (PCMN-MPC) in Sofronio Española, Palawan are continuously conducting maintenance and protection of established NGP and CARP projects including patrolling within the project areas.

There are 123 CSC holders evaluated in the municipality of Brooke's Point, Palawan, with status as follows:
