Background	<p>Article II Section 16 of the Philippine Constitution of 1987 provides that “The State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature”.</p> <p>Pursuant to DAO 2004-55, the DENR shall conduct the orientation of Wildlife Enforcement Officer (WEO) immediately prior to assumption of duty to ensure that they will effectively perform their functions.</p> <p>In order to mobilize these WEO’s, there is a need to institutionalize the collaboration among concerned government agencies and private sectors to prevent illegal wildlife trade and extinction of wildlife to promote balance ecosystem.</p> <p>This learning event/orientation will capacitate and inform the participants with regards to the duties and functions of Wildlife Enforcement Officers. This training will be in collaboration with the Regional Office who will provide resource persons to discuss specific topics pertaining to protection and conservation of wildlife.</p>

To deputize Wildlife Enforcement Officers within the province of Marinduque;</li> <li>3.
