Greetings of peace and good health!

For almost fifty (50) years, the **National Food Authority (NFA)** Romblon Provincial Office committedly gave its best in providing public service for the people of Romblon. Due to the implementation of R.A. No. 11203<sup>1</sup> which paved the way for the organizational restructuring of the NFA, the Romblon Provincial Office was merged and became part of the NFA Batangas Branch Office.

Due to the said organizational restructuring of the NFA, several of our employees in Romblon opted to avail the early retirement program while some chose to stay with the Agency and were reassigned to other NFA Branch Offices. This resulted in the minimal office space usage at our office thereat.

In order to still utilize our office building and somehow generate additional funds, we are planning to lease out partly and/or the whole office building to a possible lessee. But, as a part of this process, the NFA must first obtain complete documentation of ownership of the property donated by the Municipal Government.

In light of this, NFA Batangas Branch Office is knocking on your door once more to inquire about the progress of our request for an approved survey for NFA's remaining untitled property of 725 square meters (725m<sup>2</sup>) in Bagacay, Romblon.

All the lacking requirements for the approval of the survey were successfully forwarded last September 03, 2021. The agency is seeking your assistance to complete the acquisition of the property's title and ownership.

We would greatly appreciate your usual favorable prompt response with regards to our request.
