: NTF-RTF-ELCAC Implementation of Ways Forward and Institutionalizing the Culture of Collaboration, Coordination, and Synchronization

In connection with the recently concluded region-wide NTF-RTF Summing Up Meeting, the NTF-ELCAC will hold a follow-up meeting entitled: "NTF-RTF-ELCAC Implementation of Ways Forward and Institutionalizing the Culture of Collaboration, Coordination, and Synchronization". The objective of this activity are the following:

- a. To update the NTF-ELCAC on the milestones of progress on the implementation of the identified Way Forwards/Targets;
- b. To harmonize the 12 Clusters and its sub-clusters on the enactment of policies, programs, project services and activities at the national and regional level;
- c. To formulate catch-up plans to address the identified gaps and/or challenges, and lay down the restated targets/goals of each JRTFs, particular of its regional cluster, to attain its objective until June 2022; and
- d. To institutionalize the culture of collaboration, coordination, and synchronization in the JTRFs and 12 Clusters on the overall impact of the NTF-ELCAC efforts beyond the Duterte Administration.

In this regard, using the herein attached **Annex "A"** as template format, it is hereby requested from your kind offices to submit, **on or before March 18**, **2022**, List of ELCAC related projects, programs, or activities (PPAs) that are for implementation of your respective offices for **CY 2022** at Identified Communist Terror Group (CTG) Affected and Cleared Barangays (**Annex "B"**).

To show that the PPAs are in-line with the objectives of the **MIMAROPA Infrastructure and Resource Management (IRM) Cluster**, please be guided with the following parameters:

- a. For PNP, AFP, NICA, and other law enforcement member agencies of the MIMAROPA IRM Cluster, the accomplishment report should at least contain PPAs related to security being provided to vital infrastructures, tourism sites, farmers or fisherfolks communities and the likes, as well as activities that aims to eliminate extortion and like activities of CTGs. Examples of these are the CIIPSOs being provided at infrastructure project sites and orientations, seminars or forums conducted to government personnel, contractors or other stakeholders regarding CTG and their extortion activities;
- For NCIP, DAR, and DENR, kindly provide data as to the numbers of land titles (CADTs, CLOAs, Agricultural Free Patents and the likes) awarded to Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples (ICCs/IPs) and/or qualified beneficiaries as well as other PPAs that recognizes the rights of ICCs/IPs;
- c. For **DPWH**, **DICT**, **DOT**, **DOT**, **PPA**, **NIA**, **DA**, and **DOE**, please provide data on CY 2022 infrastructure projects at identified CTG cleared and/or affected barangays; and
- d. For **all other member agencies of the MIMAROPA IRM Cluster**, kindly provide data on PPAs that aims to protect or preserve our resources that were implemented at identified CTG cleared and/or affected barangays.

B. Activity Flow Design:

1. Concept and Program Design.

2. Invitation Letters to Participants and Resource Persons, Speakers, and Registration;

The Clusters and all JRTFs shall draft and send out invitation letters to the dignitaries, speakers, resource persons, and other participants.

3. Documentation and Writing of the Proceedings Report

The JRTFs shall document the proceedings and submit the presentation, briefing script, and Way Forward Monitoring Matrix to the NTF-ELCAC Secretariat (Attention: Directorate for Operations at operationsdirectoratate@ntfelcac.org) 2 days prior to their respective schedules. The After Activity Report shall be submitted 1 week after the activity through the JRTF's Operations Center.

4. Moderator

JRTFs shall assign the Host/Moderator during the conduct of the activity.

5. Technical Support

The Zoom Meeting Room with at least 1,000 participants capacity and technical support shall be provided by the NTF-ELCAC Secretariat. However, the National Clusters and JRTFs can also use their own meeting rooms.
