The aforementioned personnel shall perform the day-to-day operations of the Special Committee and assist it in the performance of its functions, to wit:

1. Conduct continuing assessment and updating of the inventory of illegally or irregularly issued land patents/registered titles nationwide;

2. Investigate, *motu proprio*, or upon complaint or upon instructions of the Secretary, the circumstances surrounding illegally o irregularly issued land patents/registered titles to determine the propriety of initiating reversion cases pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 2016-31 and other relevant laws, rules and regulations;

3. Evaluate and review the legal and technical bases of cases recommended for cancellation or reversion by the Regional Executive Director concerned or any other official or office;

4. Intensify the information and education campaign against illegally or irregularly issued land patents/ registered titles;

5. Recommend policies or guidelines in the disposition of cases of illegally or irregularly issued land patents/registered titles;

6. Endorse to the appropriate offices the conduct of administrative investigations on officials and employees involved in the processing of the illegally or irregularly issued land patents/registered titles; and

7. Perform other relevant tasks and functions.

All expenses to be incurred in the performance of the tasks under this Special Order shall be charged against the appropriate funds of the Department which are particularly allotted for this purpose, subject to the existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately.

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
