Presidential Directive no. 2022-011

TO : The Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)
The Administrator of the Office of Civil Defense (OCD)

SUBJECT : **CONVERSION OF FALLEN TREES INTO REUSABLE HOUSING MATERIALS FOR TYPHOON ODETTE SURVIVORS**

DATE : JAN 28 2022

During the President's Talk to the People on January 24, 2022, the President expressed his openness to engage the services of qualified chainsaw operators and workers who will assist the government in cutting and converting fallen trees into reusable housing materials.

Thus, the President directed the DENR and OCD to conduct following, subject to relevant laws, rules and regulations:¹

1. Implement a mechanism to engage the services of qualified chainsaw operators and workers who will assist in converting fallen trees into reusable lumber for the construction of houses for Typhoon Odette victims; and
2. Coordinate with the DBM and OP-ODESFA on the needed funding to remunerate interested licensed chainsaw owners and users for their service.

We note that this memorandum is being issued as a formality as this directive had been communicated ahead to the DENR Secretary and to the OCD Administrator given his presence during the meeting.

Kindly submit a report on your compliance with this directive, indicating the reference number above, not later than fifteen (15) days upon receipt of this memorandum, to the Presidential Management Staff through directives@pms.gov.ph, and regular updates thereafter until the directive has been fully complied with.
