Follow up on Lifting and Recall of the Cease Re:

and Desist Order dated 7 March 2022

Gentlemen:

On behalf of **Ten Knots Philippines**, **Inc.** ("TKPI"), we again follow up our request for the lifting and recall of your Cease and Desist Order ("CDO") dated 7 March 2022.

Upon inquiry with Attorney Jansen I. Jontila on the status of our request, we were informed that Ms. Remedios C. Cabral ("Ms. Cabral") was given time to comment thereon. With all due respect, Ms. Cabral's position on whether to lift and recall the CDO is not relevant and only results in delay. This urgent matter clearly calls for this Honorable Office to act with utmost dispatch due to the damage and prejudice that TKPI has been suffering and will continue to suffer on a daily basis.

In lieu of awaiting Ms. Cabral's submission of her comment, we respectfully submit that the CDO should be lifted immediately because TKPI has submitted to the Free and Prior Informed Consent ("FPIC") process and has submitted all necessary documents to facilitate the FPIC process.

The detriment caused by the continuance of the CDO to the communities affected as well as the Municipality of El Nido also call for the immediate lifting and recall of the CDO. The Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of El Nido recently issued a Resolution requesting your office to reconsider and recall the CDO because it has affected and will continue to affect not only the locals employed

by TKPI, but also the LGU's efforts to revive the local economy. The LGU is also concerned that the CDO will adversely affect its local tax collection. A copy of Resolution No. 22-67 issued by the *Office of the Sangguniang Bayan* of the Municipality of El Nido is attached for your reference.

All told, the issues for resolution of your good office are: (1) whether TKPI has submitted to the FPIC process; and (2) whether TKPI's submissions to facilitate that process are complete. Clearly, TKPI has categorically submitted to the FPIC process and submitted all required documents. We reiterate our position in our letter dated 21 March 2022 and maintain that there is no lawful basis to further delay and/or defer action on TKPI's request for the lifting and recall of the CDO. The CDO is harmful and benefits no one.

Finally, TKPI respectfully requests a meeting, at your most convenient time, to discuss the next steps to keep the FPIC process moving.



A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NATIONAL COMMISSION ON INDIGENOUS PEOPLES (NCIP) MIMAROPA REGION TO RECONSIDER AND RECALL THE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER (CDO) THEY ISSUED TO TEN KNOTS PHILIPPINES, INC. (TKPI) ON MARCH 7, 2022.

WHEREAS, on 15 March 2022, the Municipal Government of El Nido, through its Municipal Mayor, Honorable Edna Gacot-Lim was furnished a copy of TKPI's letter, written by ACCRA Law Office, addressed to the NCIP, MIMAROPA Region, requesting the reconsideration and recall of the CDO while the FPIC process is going on;

WHEREAS, after scanning the pages of the letter and its attachments, this august body arrived at the opinion that the CDO has no factual and legal basis;

WHEREAS, the CDO will affect a number of employees employed by the TKPI's project, damage the businesses and enterprises reliant on the daily operations of Lio Airport, the operation of Iloilo-Negros Air Express Company (INAEC), the Joint Task Force Malampaya who land their aircrafts at the Lio Airport, the seaport, hotel and retail establishments located in Villa Libertad and Pasadeña;

WHEREAS, all of the above would block all efforts to revive the local economy which has been devastated by the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, it is the honest belief of this august body that the CDO has more adverse than beneficial effects to the municipality;



WHEREAS, it is a common knowledge that no member of any Indigenous Peoples is discriminated at all the TKPI establishments in El Nido;

WHEREAS, it is the understanding of this august body that the TKPI is abiding with all the processes pursuant to R.A. No. 8371, the Indigenous Peoples Rights Act of 1997;

WHEREAS, the closure of TKPI establishments in Villa Libertad and Pasadeña would also mean a significant loss in the local tax collection at this municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Llanera and were jointly seconded by SB Member Legaspi and SB Member Lim, be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) MIMAROPA Region to reconsider and recall the Cease and Desist Order (CDO) they issued to Ten Knots Philippines, Inc. (TKPI) on March 7, 2022.
