Forwarded is the memorandum dated March 24, 2022 of Marine Biologist II Genesis Z. Ustares of Snake Island NCMCR.

As per report, the monitoring was conducted on March 24, 2022 to check the condition of the ARMS unit in 18 meters depth in the deployment area (09°54'21.6" N, 118°49'24.7" E. The team was composed of Snake Island certified divers.

Further, the visibility is clear at 8 meters' depth with a sea temperature of 29°C, new coral recruits were observed near the ARMS unit and sightings of groupers, damsel, wrasses and bream fishes were also recorded in the area.

Respectfully submitted is the activity report of the undersigned on ARMS monitoring activity in Snake Island – National Coastal and Marine Center for Research.

A monthly schedule for ARMS monitoring was set on March 24, 2022 to regularly check the condition of the ARMS unit after its redeployment activity on August 15, 2019. Research Assistant Jamael B. Masacal and Law Enforcement Officer Dioniso A. Mahilum Jr. carried out this month's monitoring activity.

The ARMS unit was spotted in the deployment area (09°54'21.6" N, 118°49'24.7" E) at 18 meters' depth with a visibility of 8 meters and a sea temperature of 29°C and conducted appropriate actions. New coral recruits were observed near the ARMS unit and there's also sightings of groupers, damsel, wrasses and bream fishes. Attached is the photo documentation of the activity.


