1. GOVERNMENT OF CANADA WILL REMOVE PRE-ENTRY TEST REQUIREMENT FOR FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELERS ON APRIL 1, 2022

Effective April 1, 2022 at 12:01 AM EDT, fully vaccinated travellers will no longer need to provide a pre-entry COVID-19 test result to enter Canada by air, land or water. But Fully vaccinated travellers seeking to arrive in Canada before April 1, 2022, must still have a valid pre-entry test.

3. SINGAPORE FURTHER EASES TRAVEL RESTRICTION FOR SHORT TERM VISITORS

All short-term foreign visitors who are fully vaccinated entering Singapore from April 01, 2022 are no longer required to have COVID-19 travel insurance.

Entry Document Requirements for fully vaccinated passengers:

1. Negative COVID-19 Test (PCR, Antigen, LAMP, NAAT PCR) taken within 2 days before departure or Proof of Recovery (for recovered travelers) or PDT Exemption Letter
2. Proof of vaccination
3. Singapore Arrival Card – Mandatory to submit 3 days before entering Singapore

All Visitors must use the [TraceTogether app](#) in Singapore to facilitate contact tracing. After leaving Singapore, the TraceTogether app data must be kept for 21 days.

4. UPDATED ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO INDONESIA

Effective immediately, reservation of hotel for quarantine before arriving in Jakarta is no longer required. Fully vaccinated travelers is also no longer required to serve quarantine but will still need to do a PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) test upon arrival on top of pre-departure test requirement. If the traveler has received only one dose of vaccination, then they must quarantine for 5 days.

Below are the pre-departure requirements:

1. Recognized Proof of Vaccination which shows complete (full dose) COVID-19 vaccine card/certificate (printed/digital) that has been done minimum 14 days before departure date written in English or origin country language, i
2. Negative result of RT-PCR Covid-19 test from the origin country/city which sample taken on the period of 48 hours before departure. No exemption for all ages including Infant.
3. Install and pre-register in the PeduliLindungi application (download for [Android](#) / [iOS](#)) and filled out the Indonesian e-HAC
4. Travel insurance which covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of USD25,000
5. RT-PCR test on Arrival. The price of PCR test is IDR 275,000 or USD 20.00 can be paid by cash or credit. If on-arrival PCR test is negative and passenger is fully vaccinated or have received booster at minimum 14 days prior the departure will be able to continue the journey (without undergoing quarantine).

Quarantine: For passengers with single dose of Covid-19 vaccine or unvaccinated must undergo 5 days quarantine. Quarantine facilities are prepared by the government facility for Indonesia Migrant Workers, Students (free) or in designated hotels at own expenses (for general Indonesian Citizens)

Additional Bali Requirements:

6. Proof of hotel booking confirmation minimum 4 days stay in Bali
7. Register to Electronic Custom Declaration
8. VOA (Visa on Arrival) worth IDR 500,000 (approximately USD35) which will be paid upon arrival at Bank BRI counters before the Immigration check in the Arrival Hall.

Regulations on PCR tests and mandatory quarantine are frequently changed. Please check Indonesia Government's Official website <https://covid19.go.id/> for full details (right click on the website homepage for the option to translate to English).

5. MALAYSIA BORDER REOPENING PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE 01 APRIL 2022

Malaysia will open its borders to international travelers without quarantine for fully vaccinated passengers effective 01 April 2022. Travelers will only have to undergo a COVID-19 reverse transcription-polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) test two days before departure and a professional COVID-19 rapid test kit-antigen (RTK-Ag) test within 24 hours after arrival in Malaysia.

General Requirements:

1. Negative COVID-19 PCR Test taken within 2 days before departure or Proof of Recovery (for recovered travelers)
2. Download, Register and activate MySejahtera <https://mysejahtera.malaysia.gov.my/intro/>

Successful completion, will generate Traveller Card:

- Fully vaccinated travelers will be issued a “Digital Travelers Card” (Blue Traveller Card).
 - Partially vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers will be issued a “Digital Home Surveillance Order (HSO)” for 5 days (Red Traveller Card).
 - Travelers without a “Digital Travelers Card” or “ Digital Home Surveillance Order” will not be permitted to continue travel.
3. Travel and Health Insurance with minimum coverage of USD20,000
 4. Rapid test kit-antigen (RTK-Ag) test within 24 hours after arrival in Malaysia

Travellers who are partially vaccinated or unvaccinated are required to undergo 5 days quarantine at their place of residence.
