We would like to inform you that PhilGEPS will be conducting the **Trainer's Training Refresher Course** for the **Modernized PhilGEPS** (mPhilGEPS). We will provide an update to the following functionalities: Annual Procurement Plan, Purchase Request, eBidding, Award Notice, AMP Publication and Contract Implementation modules. Functionalities for the Consulting services and Pre-bid conference will also be tackled.
