
Due to the varying COVID-19 Alert Levels across our Green fins sites and inactivity of the tourism industry, the conduct of Green Fins Environmental Risk Assessments is still difficult to undertake. In lieu of this, the following activities may be considered as alternative:

1. **Contact members to establish business status and whether they want to continue as Green Fins members.**
Output: Updated inventory with business and membership status
2. **Conduct Green Fins awareness raising sessions with other DENR staff only if travel is possible and safe to do so**
Output: Activity Report (with no. of participants, and Sex Disaggregated Data)
3. **Production of member packs targeting the highest threats based on the last assessments in that location**
Output: Member packs with posters related to highest threats
4. **Conduct of meeting to be able to come up with solutions to highest threats based on the last assessment analysis**
Output: Minutes of the meeting/Solution protocols
5. **Capacity building activities (SCUBA diving Certification, refresher, etc.)**
Output: Activity report
6. **Conduct of clean-up activities with Green Fins members**
Output: Log of members participating, log of participants

The conduct of **Environmental Risk Assessments** is encouraged wherever it is safe and possible to do. Otherwise, constant communication with your respective Green Fins member establishments should at least be maintained.
