


Daily and monthly Accomplishment report

APRIL 01-03, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conducted monitoring survey of mangrove assessment plots and repainted the marks on mangroves faded with red paints.
APRIL 04-05, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Preparing and the cleaning the building for upcoming dry season marine assessment preparation with coordination with ERDB and BMB representatives. We prepare the utensil and plates.
