OF THE UNLAWFUL OCCUPANTS/SQUATTERS WITHIN THE CSC AREA OF JO-AN BERONILLA-ACHURRA LOCATED AT SITIO LOGPOND, PORT

BARTON, SAN VICENTE, PALAWAN

The subject of the investigation conducted are the following issues raised by the Purok President in his letter, dated June 27, 2016, to the CENRO and during the interview/interrogation with the said unlawful occupants at the area conducted during the ocular inspection on July 18, 2016, to wit:

- 1. How did Jo-an Beronilla-Achurra have the right to property which belong to the late Ernesto Pflieder:
- 2. Why was the CSC of Maximino Beronilla (CSC No. 04250113) had been renewed when this has no improvement introduced by the CSC Holder therein:
- 3. Why was the CSC renewed when it had long been expired and abandoned; and,
- 4. Why was the CSC transferred to Jo-an Beronilla-Achurra.

#### **ISSUE NO. 1**

The Investigating Team, upon conducting an ocular inspection at the area. found out that the area mentioned by the complainant claimed by Jo-an Beronilla-Achurra is not the land owned by Mr. Pfleider. It is the adjacent lot.



#### **ISSUE NO. 2**

The Team have witnessed that contrary to the allegation of the unlawful occupants, the area is already developed. It was planted with different kind of fruit trees and coconut. Most of which are already bearing (please see attached picture of the panoramic view of the area taken during the inspection on July 18, 2016).

Meanwhile, certain Mr. Enrique Ponteras testified that he was hired by Jo-an Beronilla-Achurra to plant 100 coconut seedlings and 1,000 Mahogany seedlings in the area three (3) years ago, unfortunately, they uprooted them causing damages to the CSC holder.

At present, more or less twenty five (25) houses have been constructed within the CSC area by them who, however, expressed their willingness to vacate the area, provided, that the structures they built therein will be paid.

#### ISSUE NO. 3

CSC No. 04250113 was issued to Maximino Beronilla in 1984 and expired in 2009. However, before its expiration, the above-mentioned CSC holder died in June, 2002. For reasons not known by this office, none of his relatives reported his death to this Office and may have applied for the transfer of the said CSC to the next-of-kin.

Until 2014, a certain Jo-an Beronilla-Achura appeared to this Office claiming that she is the granddaughter of late Maximino Beronilla who died in June, 2002. She showed her credentials as the nearest kin of the late CSC holder, hence, she is allowed to apply for the renewal and transfer in her name the CSC awarded to her grandfather.

Accordingly, she was not aware that her grandfather has been awarded by the DENR with a piece of land for stewardship at Sitio Logpond, Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan. Not until she met a former friend of her grandfather who informed her about the said CSC area.

It was not a case of abandonment, but a case of unfortunate circumstances there the grantee failed to continue to cultivate and work on the stewarded land due his death.

#### ISSUE NO. 4

As provided under our existing Forest Laws, Rules and Regulations, upon the death or incapacity of the Grantee, the CSC will be transferred to Grantee next-of-kin, provided that at least 50% of the area covered by the CSC has been developed.

The terms and conditions of the CSC also stipulates that upon expiration of the Stewardship Agreement, the Grantee or the next-of-kin shall have the right of preemption to any subsequent Stewardship Agreement covering their occupied area.

#### COMMENTS:

It has been a public knowledge that the subject area had been awarded to the late Maximino Beronilla as his CSC area, and yet the unlawful occupants who have been complaining about the renewal and transfer of the said CSC, entered and squatted at the said CSC area. They took advantage when the grantee died and his nearest relatives are not around. Their act is definitely punishable by law. Their refusal to leave the area without the payment of their establishments from the grantee has no legal basis and is prejudicial to the Grantee.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

Therefore, it is hereby recommended that if they will refuse to vacate the area, a Criminal Complaint be filed in court against them.

#### I. REFERENCES:

- A. Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) No. 042502113 issued by this Office dated 5 March 1984 covering an area of 3.0 hectares located at Brgy. Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan;
- B. Report re: evaluation of Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) No. 042502113 awarded to Maximino Torre Beronilla dated 11 November 2003 signed by Silverio C. Lagan; Desk Officer and Jovencito S. Gabinete; CBFM Staff which strongly nominating Ms. Jo-ann Beronilla-Achurra to be the transferor of the subject CS area;
- C. Annotation at the back of CS contract dated 14 November 2003 stating that Jo-ann Beronilla Achurra as the qualified heir/successor of the subject CS area, signed by Mrs. Jo-Ann Beronilla-Achurra attested by the late CENRO Wilfredo R. Angeles
- D. Letter dated 15 February 2009, 17 March 2010, 28 June 2012 and 12 December 2014 of Mrs. Jo-ann Beronilla-Achurra both informing this Office of her intention to continue the development and improvement and also asking for a help in the eviction of the illegal settlers occupying the subject CS area;
- E. Inspection/Verification report dated 19 May 2014 submitted by Esperlita R. Sotoza, Jovencito S. Gabinete and Silverio C. Lagan with the recommendation to renew the subject CS Area;

#### LEGAL BASIS:

- A. Section 78 of PD 705 as amended -Unlawful Occupation or Destruction of Forestlands- "any persons who enters and occupies or possesses, or makes kaingin for his own private use or for others, any forestland without authority under a license agreement, lease, license, or permit....";
- **B.** Letter D.; General Provisions- Paragraph 5 "This Stewardship Agreement is non-transferable..."; and
- C. DENR memorandum Circular No. 1993-23 dated July 08, 1993 or the Revised Procedure on the Transfer of Certificate of Stewardship to the next-of-kin of the holders thereof". Whereas, other nominated persons or party possessing the necessary qualifications may also be appointed by the original steward. PROVIDED, however,

With the arguments as to the irregularities and improperly renewing the above subject CS Contract in favour of Mrs. Jo-Ann Beronilla- Achurra, answers to the said arguments, to wit:

- That before the CS Contract expires on 05 March 2009, Mrs. Jo-Ann Beronilla-Achurra submitted a letter dated 15 February 2009 (copy hereto attach) to renew likewise informing this Office her sincere intention to continue to develop and improve her CS area also informing our Office about the destructions made by the intruders/squatters/illegal occupants in the area;
- That there were evaluation/assessment conducted with corresponding report strongly nominating Mrs. Jo-Ann Beronilla- Achurra prior to the transfer of the CS Contract through annotation at the back of the Original CS contract per Section 11 of DAO No. 4, Series of 1991, as amended;
- That there were evaluation/assessment conducted with corresponding report and performance evaluation with a passing score of 72 points and a recommendation that it is meritorious for RENEWAL;
- 4. That despite of the challenges faced by the Beronilla family from getting ill of the original CSC Grantee, and eventually died in 2002 also the only next-of-kin in the name of Maximino Beronilla, Jr., which was also died in 2003, the next generation of Beronilla in the name of Mrs. Jo-Ann Beronilla- Achurra which was grown in Barangay Port Barton where the CS area is located stand-up for the privileged given by the government and is willingly to take the duties and responsibilities over the area with CS Contract;
- 5. That it is clear that all of the illegal occupants intruded in the subject CS area took advantage when the original Grantee died and his nearest relatives are not around. However, it is unlawful and is punishable by law. Their refusal to vacate the are without payment of their establishments from the grantee has no legal basis and is prejudice to the grantee;
- 6. That in her letter dated 21 September 2020 to our Regional Executive Director, she emphasized clearly that she had made all of her might just to win back the CS area and continue the duties and responsibilities given by the government to their family as steward of that area to include her submission and completion of all the required documents by this Office at that time; and
- 7. That it is unfair to the Transferee/Grantee that only to be now told that there were lacking reports and other documents needed to prove the legitimacy of the transfer and renewal of the CS Contract which is in contrary to the fact that there were inspection reports, investigation conducted with reports and other supporting documents submitted with regards to the transfer and renewal of the subject CS area and contract in favour of Ms. Jo-ann Beronilla-Achurra. Likewise, it is beyond the control of the Grantee/Transferee as to the time of renewal of the CS contract which is in the year 2014.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION:

Per review of all the documents, it is clearly shows that the processes of the transfer of the CS contract in favour of Mrs. Jo-ann Beronilla-Achurra is legitimate. Hence, there were actions taken by her as previously required by our Office and also there were evaluations conducted by our personnel with corresponding reports.

Therefore it is hereby recommended that the CS area be subjected to a **RELOCATION SURVEY** based on the area renewed/transferred in favour of the above TRANSFEREE to settle once and for all the claims and conflicts and also the new Grantee may continue the development of the CS area as her lawful intention from the very beginning.





Respectfully submitted herewith our report regarding the request of Joan Beronilla Achurra , the grand daughter of the late CSC holder, findings are stated hereunder, to wit:

#### The Area:

The area is classified as timberland, covered with CSC No. 042502113 awarded to late Maximo Beronilla on March 05, 1984 with an approximate area of 3.00 hectares, in accordance with the Letter of Instruction (LOI) 1260.

The tenured area is planted with fruit trees with second growth species found at the northern portion of the area.

In November 10, 2003, the Stewardship was transferred to Joan Beronilla Achurra who appeared as his nearest kin

#### **Environmental Activities**

A, Forest Protection

Due to the absence of the transferee in the tenured area, about 10 families of fisher folks entered a portion of the area along the coastal side. No destruction of natural grown trees have been discovered.

#### B. Reforestation / Nursery

The lower portion of the area is planted with fruit trees and second growth species were also observed in some portion of the tenured area. No existing nursery in the area.

#### Improvements / Development

Aside from the observed shanties created by the fisher folks, one (1) residential house is also found within the area where the care taker with his family stay.

#### Recommendation

In view hereof, it is meritorious that his Certificate of Stewardship Contract be renewed.
