This has reference to your Memorandum dated 06 April 2022 regarding your report on the monitoring and ocular inspection of the activities in the NHA-Yolanda Permanent Housing Project (YPHP) in Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan within the Busuanga Pasture Reserve (BPR).

Review of the report disclosed that the BPR Management Office personnel, together with the representatives from CENRO Calamianes Islands, Front Nine Konstruct (Builders and Realty Development) Corp., Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), and Municipal Planning Development Office of Coron conducted a joint monitoring and ocular inspection on the recent activities of the YPHP, as well as the status of the project last 18 March 2022. While it was mentioned that there is no observed on-going construction in the area due to the directives from the Forest Management Bureau, it was mentioned in the report, however, that residents of Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan disclosed that there is still an on-going operation onsite.

In this regard, it is suggested that our Bantay Gubat should give preferential attention in the area. Also, request the assistance of the DENR MIMAROPA field personnel, particularly CENRO Calamianes Islands, in the performance of your task.

In compliance with Travel Order No. 2021-054 dated 18 March 2022 respectfully submitted the report of the undersigned BPR Management Office personnel together with GIS Focal personnel of CENRO-Coron regarding the monitoring and ocular inspection on the activities of NHA-Yolanda Permanent Housing Project (YPHP) in Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron Palawan within BPR area. Also, instructed by the CENR Officer to remind/ advised the Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS) on the status/ latest development in meeting with YOLANDA IATF.

On March 18, 2022, the undersigned BPRMO personnel together with the representatives from the Contractor of NHA-YPHP, Front Nine Konstruct (Builders & Realty Development) Corp., Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Planning-Municipality of Coron and CENRO Coron, proceeded to Brgy. San Nicolas to conduct monitoring and ocular inspection on the recent activities of NHA-YPHP as well as the status of the project.

On-site, on the day of monitoring and ocular inspection the undersigned observed that there is no ongoing construction in the area. During the interview according to Engr. John Rhyan Cabalar of NHA-YPHP, the status of the project was around 27.22% for the Coron Heights (located in front of the area) and 26.75% of the Coron Residences (located at the back of the area). One of the contractors said that around 400 units were almost done while the majority of the units are still unfinished. To have an overview of the project a drone was used to take photo documentation (please see attached photos).

Engr. Cabalar also mentioned that they were instructed to issue a temporary suspension of the construction of the project to the contractor (Front Nine Konstruct (Builders & Realty Development) Corp.), since there is an ongoing problem with regards to the location of the project. The said suspension accordingly is in compliance with the directives of DENR-Forest Management Bureau to immediately hold in abeyance the construction of the aforesaid housing project. However, information gathered by the BPRMO from residence of Brgy. San Nicolas Coron Palawan that they are still operating onsite.

Also, during the interview it was explained to the contractors that there will be another meeting regarding this matter.

The undersigned personnel recommends that regular monitoring of the project location must be conducted to have an update on the status, activities, latest development and compliance of the NHA to the directives and instruction of the higher authority.





Figure 1. Coordination of the undersigned personnel (Left to right) Ronald Lara Planning-Municipality of Coron, Engr. John Rhyan Cabalar NHA-YPHP, Richard John Galagate FMB/BPRMO, Ariel Delin II CENRO Coron, Desiree Sandoval FMB/BPRMO and Albert Manlavi PCSD.

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
Figure 5. Aerial view of the site of NHA-YPHP at Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan. Coron Residences (Color blue roof at the right side) located at the back of the area showing that approximately 200 units were finished while majority were still under construction.
