Dear Madam/Sir:

Please be informed that on 15 June 2021, CENRO - Coron confirmed that BCT Trading and Construction (BCT) is conducting illegal sand and gravel extraction in Papualan River, Brgy. Decalachao, Coron, Palawan.

The above-cited extraction and disposition of sand and gravel materials without any mining and/or transport permit is equivalent to theft of minerals pursuant to Section 103 of Republic Act (RA) No. 79421, which provides that:

"Theft of Minerals – Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement lease, permit, license, or steals mineral or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants..xxx"

Hence, BCT is hereby ordered to immediately CEASE AND DESIST from conducting illegal sand and gravel activities in the area without the necessary mining permit and delivery receipt. This is without prejudice to the filing of appropriate charges against the company with the proper court for violation of the applicable provisions of RA No. 4942.

Please be guided accordingly.

Dear Mr. T. G. Tiotangco:

This refers to the investigation report dated 26 February 2021 by the technical personnel of CENRO – Coron, re: "Investigation Report on the Alleged Illegal Sand and Gravel Operation at Umaya River, Brgy. Guadalupe, Coron, Palawan."

The corresponding investigation results confirmed that BCT Construction Inc. is engaged in the illegal sand and gravel activity at Umaya River, Barangay Guadalupe, Coron, Palawan.

Please be informed that Section 103 of Republic Act (RA) No. 7942, otherwise known as the *Philippine Mining Act of 1995*, provides that:

"Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement, lease, permit, license, or steals minerals or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned from six (6) months to six (6) years or pay a fine from Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) to Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00), or both, at the discretion of the appropriate court. In addition, he shall be liable to pay damages and compensation for the minerals removed, extracted, and disposed of. xxx."

Hence, you hereby ordered to immediately **CEASE AND DESIST** from conducting sand and gravel activities in the area without the necessary mining permit. This is without prejudice to the filing of appropriate charges against your company with the proper court for violation of the applicable provisions of RA No. 7942 and DENR Administrative Order No. 2010-21.
