The COVID-19 pandemic remains to be a lurking threat to the country even amidst our consistent efforts to hamper transmission and increase inoculation across all regions. Now that the 2022 elections, a pillar of our democracy, is fast approaching, there is an urgent need to mobilize all our resources and personnel to their best capacities to assist the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in COVID-proofing the May 09, 2022 elections.

In this light, all concerned shall perform the following responsibilities during the 2022 National and Local Elections:

- a) The Office of Civil Defense (OCD) as the Executive Arm and Secretariat of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) and the National Task Force (NTF) Against COVID-19, activate the NDRRM Operations Center to RED ALERT status for heightened situation monitoring and anticipate for eventualities on 08 to 10 May 2022;
- b) The Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (RDRRMC), as chairs of the Regional Task Forces (RTF) Against COVID-19, to likewise raise to RED ALERT status their respective RDRRM Operations Centers;
- c) The RTFs to coordinate and mobilize the member agencies of the Regional Clusters, especially the Regional Response Cluster, as well as the Local Task Forces (LTF) to adhere to the requirements and needs to be set by the COMELEC through its field offices;
- d) The OCD and its Regional Offices as the head of Task Group Resource Management and Logistics, facilitate and coordinate the provision of medical supplies and other logistical requirements for COVID-19 operations as needed for the May 2022 elections; and
- e) Perform such other duties and functions which the Commission may prescribe from time to time.

Let us keep still the "Bayanihan Spirit" to ensure a safe and healthy national and local election.
