Since the Philippines declared an outbreak of African Swine Fever (ASF) in 2019, the wild pig population remains to be very susceptible to the ASF virus. In relation to the recent sighting of the Philippine Warty Pig (Sus scrofa) in Davao and alongside with the opening up of tourist areas, including those in your region, where wild pigs are known to be sighted, the National African Swine Fever Prevention and Control Program (NASFPCP) would like to invite you to a coordination meeting on May 5, 2022 at 2 PM.
