With the implementation of the Lawin Monitoring and Patrolling System, respectfully submitted is the detailed report of the Busuanga Pasture Reserve Management Office (BPRMO) on the results of the Lawin monitoring and patrolling conducted in the Municipalities of Coron and Busuanga, Palawan within the BPR area for the month of April 2022.

I. Findings and Result

Two (2) Patrol Teams were dispatched during the conduct of this activity within the Forest Conservation Area (FCA) of BPR situated in the Municipalities of Coron and Busuanga, Palawan. The target distance for month of April 2022 is 30 kilometers (km) based on the Lawin Patrol Plan for 2nd Quarter of 2022. On the said month, the BPRMO Patrol Teams were able to traverse an aggregate distance of 33.77 km or 112.56 % (Table 1).

Table 2 shows a total of 111 Forest Condition Counts (FCCs) recorded during the patrolling. Early Secondary Forest (ESF) appears to have the highest figure recorded for April 2022 with 57 counts or 51%, while Old Growth Forest has least recorded observation with 2 count or 2%. The remaining forest conditions such as: Open-Uncultivated (OUC), Open-Cultivated (OC), and Advance Secondary Forest (ASF) with corresponding total figures of 22 (20%), 18 (16%), and 12 (11%), respectively. Based on the SMART analysis, the total FC with good condition has a total count of 71 or 63.96% which includes OGF, ASF and ESF.

With respect to the presence of natural regenerants, 71 FCCs or 64% of the total FCC were recorded with presence of natural regenerants while 40 FCCs or 36% with absence of natural regenerants. There was no recorded in dense natural regenerants, while twenty-eight (28) FCCs or 25% and forty-three (43) or 39% are recorded as moderate and sparse natural regenerants, respectively (Table 3).

Table 4 shows the observed and recorded threats within the FCA of BPR. A total of 1 threat were observed and recorded during the Lawin Patrolling for this April 2022 and this were accounted to slash and burn farming (kaingin).

As can be viewed from the map in Annex C, the threats observed/documented in the FCA during the month of April 2022 are found in Barangays of Old Busuanga and San Rafael both in the Municipality of Busuanga. The current threat index is computed as 0.12 threats per kilometer (T/Km) in January 2022, up to 0.21 T/Km in month of March 2022 and down to 0.03 T/km for this month of April 2022. On the other hand, there are no threats recorder in the month of February 2022.

II. Remarks and Recommendations

- Frequency of the visibility of patrolling and LAWIN monitoring within the Forest Conservation Area of BPR is being intensified to include weekends, if necessary, in order to prevent and immediately address any possible threats within the forested areas of BPR;
- Letter address to the Barangay with record of threats observed in every conduct of LAWIN patrolling and monitoring to inform and assists them if it requires urgent action;
- 3. Observed unlawful activities in the ground is being thoroughly investigated and documented and filing of appropriate criminal complaints against the offenders pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 705 and other environmental laws, if so warrant:
- 4. Conduct of seminar/IEC to every barangay recorded with high incidence of unlawful activities within the area covered by the BPR to provide awareness and educate the community on the importance of maintaining ecological and environmental balance in the locality and the benefits that could be derived from the forest and climate change mitigation; and
- 5. Conduct of rehabilitation activities such as tree-planting, enrichment planting and assisted natural regeneration to maintain and accelerate recovery of forest cover.







This pertains to the Lawin monitoring and patrolling activities conducted by the undersigned personnel of the BPRMO on 12 April 2022 within the FCA of BPR in Barangays of Old Busuanga and San Rafael both in the Municipality of Busuanga, Palawan as per T.O. Nos. 2022-072 & 2022-073. In this regard, may we respectfully submit our report regarding the said activity.

During the said patrol the undersigned traverse a total distance of 6.20 kilometers. On the duration of patrol, patrollers recorded one (1) threats under (Kaingin) slash and burn farming with level 3 (no further action required) for the response needed.

In addition during the conduct of Lawin monitoring and patrolling it was cut early for the reason that, patrollers heard a sound of chainsaw operating onsite. As a response, the team decided to investigate the matter and later appended 1 (one) unit of chainsaw on site. A separate report will be produce on the apprehended chainsaw.

The undersigned personnel recommends that a further investigation must be conducted to identify personalities doing kaingin onsite furthermore, informed the barangay concern on the observed/recorded illegal activity happening within their area of jurisdiction. On the apprehended one unit of chainsaw, the team recommends for the conduct of administrative hearing on the matter and filing of appropriate case on court if warrant. Also, regular monitoring of these areas should be pursued to prevent other illegal activities.


