THE TWO SUSPECTED ROCKET DEBRIS FOUND WITHIN
APO REEF NATURAL PARK ON NOVEMBER 9, 2022

PLEASE BE INFORMED THAT THE COAST GUARD SUBSTATION SABLAYAN (CGSS), ASSISTED BY FOREST TECHNICIAN II ODELON I. DANGEROUS AND MENRO SABLAYAN PERSONNEL, HAS SUCCESSFULLY TRANSPORTED THE TWO SUSPECTED ROCKET DEBRIS IN APO REEF NATURAL PARK BACK TO MAINLAND SABLAYAN. THE RETRIEVAL OPERATION FOR THE LARGER DEBRIS FOUND NEAR BAHURA 10 WAS CONDUCTED ON NOVEMBER 10, 2022 AT AROUND 1630 HOURS. THIS WAS IMMEDIATELY BROUGHT TO APO ISLAND, APO REEF NATURAL PARK AND IT WAS DIVIDED INTO TWO SMALLER PIECES FOR EASE OF TRANSPORT. THE CGSS ALSO INSPECTED THE OTHER DEBRIS THAT WAS RETRIEVED BY TASK FORCE MARLEN ON NOVEMBER 9, 2022. THE DIMENSIONS OF BOTH DEBRIS PRIOR TO RETRIEVAL ARE AS FOLLOWS:
