Background

The Solid Waste Management Association of the Philippines (SWAPP), Inc. is a **non-stock, non-profit** association with members from the national government agencies, local government units (LGUs), institutional organizations, professionals, academe, students and solid waste management (SWM) practitioners who are **committed to the proper management of solid waste for a sustainable environment.** SWAPP was established in May 2000.

For 22 years, the association is operating as small non-government organization registered with SEC and BIR. The association **aims to build the capacity of its members** to manage solid waste in their respective areas. SWAPP **provides training, technical assistance, research, information exchange, and network building.** It provides technical/vocational courses on SWM accredited by the Technical and Educational Skills Development Authority (TESDA).

Objectives

- ❑ Enhance the knowledge and skills of SWM practitioners to plan and implement integrated SWM programs and projects;
- ❑ Promote information exchange and develop linkages and partnerships among SWM practitioners;
- ❑ Advocate for policy reforms to strengthen LGU capacity to implement SWM programs and projects;
- ❑ Disseminate information on various technologies without endorsing any specific technology; and
- ❑ Develop a research agenda on SWM as a basis for conducting specific research studies.
