Forwarded herewith are copies of reports/updates and summary of Lawin Patrolling conducted within the conservation area of CENRO Coron, Palawan from October 21, 2022 to November 20, 2022 with a total of 31.92 kilometers.

To date, the Lawin Unit accomplished a total of **789.18** kilometers distance patrolled with within our area of jurisdiction/Conservation Area or an equivalent of **131.63%** against our annual target of **600** kilometers.

Patrolling within the above period was maximized to surpass the targeted patrol/route. This is to ensure continuous monitoring and regular presence of our personnel within our territorial jurisdiction.

Furthermore, the sectors were deployed and continuing establishment and manning on Forest Product Monitoring Stations (FPMS) to intensify protection on all environmental related activities in the field.

This reports presents trends in observations of forest condition, regeneration, threats and indicator species. The combined presentation allows for an evaluation if protection efforts are effective, conservation targets are met and the forest achieves the desired future forest condition. Protection efforts are effective, when records of forest condition, regeneration and indicator species show an upward trend towards more observations more and denser regeneration, particularly in degraded forest areas. Increasing trends in indicator species suggest that the improved forest condition is providing a better habitat for forest dependent species. All trends presented are put in relation to the patrol effort to provide comparability. Forest cover data were derived from 2003 and 2010 NAMRIA land cover maps.
